15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - INNOVATE ARKANSAS. There is hereby
18	appropriated, to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, to be payable
19	from the General Improvement Fund, or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
20	following:
21	(A) for a transfer to the Innovate Arkansas Fund for personal services
22	and operating expenses of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission -
23	Innovate Arkansas in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000

25	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - INNOVATE ARKANSAS. There is hereby
26	appropriated, to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, to be payable
27	from the Innovate Arkansas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses
28	of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission - Innovate Arkansas for the
29	fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

35	SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

3 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Ninetieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than one (1) year; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
