Re: Arkansas Supreme Court Appropriation Request, FY 2017

Gentlemen:

Please accept this request for your consideration of the following three revisions to the FY2017 appropriation for the Arkansas Supreme Court to be considered during the upcoming Fiscal Session of the Arkansas General Assembly. None of these requests require a change to any of the agency's funding or appropriation levels.

The first change is within Section 5 of the current appropriation (Act 221 of 2015) which contains the positions which are paid through the Bar of Arkansas account. These employees are paid with cash funds which are generated as a result of the Supreme Court's management and oversight of the practice of law pursuant to Amendment 28 of the Arkansas Constitution. One of these programs, the Judges and Lawyers Assistance Program, provides counseling and related services to Arkansas judges, attorneys and law students who are impaired due to issues of drug and alcohol addiction. The current staff consists of two licensed therapists. Due to an increase in the need for their services, the JLAP program needs clerical and office assistance to support its work. We need to add an additional position to this section of the appropriation as follows:

The second change—also within Section 5 of the current appropriation and part of the Bar of Arkansas account—will add a Program Coordinator position to the Arkansas Access to Justice Commission. The Commission coordinates statewide efforts to ensure that all Arkansans have equal access to the civil justice system. The Commission's two staff oversee the work of the Commission, as well as the court's Interest on Lawyer Trust Accounts (IOLTA) program. Additional capacity is needed for the Commission to implement initiatives designed to make legal representation more affordable for and accessible to the Arkansans who need them, including Arkansans in rural and underserved areas of the state. We need to add another position to this section of the appropriation as follows:

SUPREME COURT PROGRAM COORDINATOR OF AJC GRADE 126

No increases in the appropriation levels to support these additional positions are necessary.

The third change involves an upgrade to a current position found in Section 1 of Act 221 of 2015 and is a result of a revision of job duties and responsibilities which has already taken place. The position, "CODE Q123C ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT" is a grade C115 and has previously functioned as clerical support. With recent changes to utilize technology to automate our processing of claims, we have increased the responsibilities of the position and the level of training and expertise required. The position now interacts directly with and functions consistent with the duties of other employees within the Office of the Clerk. We would, therefore, request that the position be re-titled as "Deputy Clerk" and reclassified from a Grade C115 to a Grade C117.

No increase in the appropriation levels to support the increase in grade are necessary.

I respectfully request your review and approval of these three changes during in the upcoming Fiscal Session. Should you have a question or require further information, feel free to let me know.



SECTION 6. EXTRA HELP - SUPREME COURT BAR OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Supreme Court - Bar of Arkansas for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - SUPREME COURT BAR OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Supreme Court, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Supreme Court, for

NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ACCESS TO 20 JUSTICE. The General Assembly finds that the Access to Justice Foundation 21 serves a public purpose, therefore financial accounting, general bookkeeping, 22 management and administrative services may be provided by employees of the 23 Arkansas Supreme Court and the Supreme Court Bar of Arkansas in support of 24 the Arkansas Access to Justice Foundation, Inc. 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 26 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017. 27 28 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 30 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 35

the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
