Amend Senate Bill No. 121 as originally introduced:
Page 21, insert an additional section immediately following SECTION 18 of the
"SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WAIVER AUTHORITY TO ELIMINATE COVERAGE FOR EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION. (a) The Department of Human Services shall request a waiver from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to eliminate coverage of emergency contraception medications, often called emergency contraceptive pills, "Plan B" pills, or the "morning after" pill, from the Arkansas Medicaid Program, including without limitation the Health Care Independence Program and, if implemented, the Arkansas Works Program. (b) To the extent necessary to maintain consistent state policy, the State Insurance Department shall request a waiver from the federal government to eliminate coverage of emergency contraception medications, often called emergency contraceptive pills, "Plan B" pills, or the "morning after" pill, from the qualified health plans available under the Health Care Independence Program and, if implemented, the Arkansas Works Program.
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017."
