 - (ii) Clothing;
 - (iii) Housing;
 - (iv) Utilities:

- (2) If the federal government denies the waiver application, this section shall not be implemented.
- (3) If the department does not request a wavier under subdivision (b)(l) of this section, the department shall not allocate, budget, expend, or utilize appropriations under this act for the participation of persons in the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program.

- (b) At Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, at all annual or special elections, the board of directors of each school district shall pay the expenses of the election out of the school fund.
- (c) If the school election is held with the general election, the school election shall be paid for in the manner prescribed for the general election under § 7-5-104.

- (B) Sufficient accommodations will continue to be made to protect the books, digital media, and other commodities and property owned by the public library from damage or destruction by flooding or floodwater.
- (b) A public library that is housed in a location prohibited by subdivision (a)(1) of this section on the effective date of this section may



remain in that location."
