

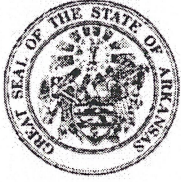

- \$10,000 is for the continuation of our effort to renew our website and add database functions to allow licensees to input basic personal data and to download application packets instead of using US Mail. This makes the data input process more accurate and speeds up the application process. This enhancement is in alignment with the Governor's call to make licensing more efficient,
- \$6,000 conference and travel expenses for board members to attend annual meeting of Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards;
- \$4,000 to hire temporary help in order to purge long standing complaint and licensee files according to DFA's document retention schedule. This is to help prepare our office for a cleaner transformation to the Health Department in FY20.

The Arkansas Psychology Board has approved this request for appropriation. The board has adequate funds available to cover these expenses. Please grant this appropriation for technology, salary, and extra labor use.
