4	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - EQUIPMENT ACQUISITIONS AND INFORMATION
5	TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
6	Transformation and Shared Services, to be payable from the Information
7,	Technology Reserve Fund, for major equipment acquisitions and information
8	technology improvements, as set out in Arkansas Code §25-4-122 and §25-4-123
9	by the Department of Transformation and Shared Services - Division of
10	Information Systems for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

17	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
19	COMPLIANCE WITH STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.
20	1. In order to effect compliance with the requirements of state and federal
21	statutory and regulatory provisions, the Director shall adjust billing rates
22	or issue billing adjustments to be federally compliant, notwithstanding the
23	provisions of ACA §25-4-105 and §25-4-119 or funds sufficient to effect
24	compliance shall be provided the Department Division from General Revenues,
25	Special Revenues or such other fund sources as may become available. These
26	actions shall be subject to the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
27	State and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
28	Committee.
29	2. The Director shall have authority to transfer funds between the
30	Information Technology Reserve Fund established by ACA §25-4-123 and the
31	Department Division of Information Systems Revolving Fund established by ACA
32	§25-4-121 for cash management purposes.
33	Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
34	appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
35	is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
36	delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

- 1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 3 has determined that the Department Division of Information Systems may
- 4 operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department
- 5 <u>Division</u> of Information Systems authorizing broad powers under this section.
- 6 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly
- 7 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or
- 8 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of
- 9 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a
- 10 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the
- 11 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
- 12 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 14 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

- 16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GIFTS.
- 18 GRANTS AND DONATIONS. (i) The Director may accept on behalf of the Department
- 19 <u>Division</u> of Information Systems, from any source, funds including but not
- 20 limited to special or general revenue, gifts, grants, cash, bequeaths,
- 21 devices, donations, real or personal property and equipment. (ii) The
- 22 Department Division shall quarterly file with the Arkansas Legislative
- 23 Council or Joint Budget Committee a report summarizing all funds, gifts,
- 24 grants, cash, bequeaths, devices, donations, real or personal property and
- 25 equipment received. (iii) The provisions of this section shall be in effect
- 26 only from July 1, 2020 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 28 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 30 PROVISION LINE ITEMS DIVISION OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS OPERATIONS. After
- 31 receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
- 32 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the
- 33 Secretary of the Department of Transformation and Shared Services is
- 34 authorized to transfer appropriation between the line items authorized herein
- 35 <u>for the Division of Information Systems Operations to best utilize</u>
- 36 <u>resources to respond to the needs of the Division's customers.</u>
