SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS. The State Medical Board is hereby authorized to expend from monies authorized herein, \$25 from each licensed physician licensed by the State Medical Board each year to be paid by the State Medical Board to 501(c)(3) Arkansas foundations that have healthcare professionals on their board and provide for identification, treatment and monitoring of healthcare professionals who suffer from alcohol or drug abuse problems, in order to promote the public health and safety and to insure the continued availability of skilled and highly trained medical professionals for the benefit of the

public.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1 2016

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{2017}$ through June 30, $\frac{2017}{2018}$.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefore, if:

- (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and
- (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the legal counsel to be retained by the agency, and
- (3) The Attorney General receives confirmation in writing from the agency that the agency will re-advertise annually for legal counsel if outside legal counsel is hired and that any amount to be paid for outside legal counsel will receive prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council

12	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-95-304(b)(2), concerning inspectors of
13	prescriptions, orders, and records, is amended to read as follows:
14	(2) The inspectors shall have the duty and authority upon
15	written direction by the Executive Secretary <u>Director</u> of the Arkansas State
16	Medical Board to investigate, inspect, and make copies of the records,
17	orders, and prescriptions, wherever located, of all persons licensed by the
18	board in order to determine whether or not the persons have:
19	(A) Violated the laws of the State of Arkansas or of the
20	United States respecting the prescription and use of narcotics and
21	potentially dangerous drugs;
22	(B) Practiced their profession in such a way as to
23	endanger the general health and welfare of the public; or
24	(C) Violated the provisions of the Arkansas Medical
25	Practices Act, \S 17-95-201 et seq., \S 17-95-301 et seq., and \S 17-95-401 et
26	seq.
27	
28	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-95-305(b), concerning disposition of
29	funds of the Arkansas State Medical Board, is amended to read as follows:
30	(b)(l) All moneys received by the board shall be disbursed by the
31	Chair of the Arkansas State Medical Board or the Executive $\frac{Secretary}{Director}$
32	of the Arkansas State Medical Board.
33	(2) The chair or the executive secretary director, or both,
34	shall furnish a surety bond and $\frac{1}{2}$ shall keep a true and faithful account
35	of all moneys received and all moneys expended.

(3) The executive $\frac{1}{2}$ director shall file annually with

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1	the Governor a report of all financial transactions duly audited by an
2	independent accountant.
3	
4	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-95-501(b)(3), concerning legislative
5	intent of the subchapter on critical medical shortage areas, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(3) It is the further intent of this subchapter that neither the
8	board nor the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical
9	Board, when acting in behalf of the board and under authority granted to him
10	or her by the board, shall be liable, collectively or individually, for civil
11	damages from claims pertaining to the administration of this subchapter.
12	
13	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 17-95-505 is amended to read as follows:
14	17-95-505. Nonliability of board.
15	In the application of the authorities and provisions of this
16	subchapter, neither the Arkansas State Medical Board, either individually or
17	collectively, $\underline{\text{nor}}$ $\underline{\text{and}}$ the Executive $\underline{\text{Secretary}}$ $\underline{\text{Director}}$ of the Arkansas State
18	Medical Board, when acting on behalf of the board, $\frac{1}{2}$ shall be $\frac{1}{2}$ be $\frac{1}{2}$ are not
19	liable for civil damages from claims pertaining to the administration of the
20	provisions of this subchapter.
21	
22	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-99-305(a), concerning temporary permits
23	of respiratory care practitioners, is amended to read as follows:
24	(a) In cases of emergency, the Executive Secretary <u>Director</u> of the
25	Arkansas State Medical Board may issue a temporary permit without examination
26	to practice respiratory care to persons who are not licensed in other states,
27	but who otherwise meet the qualifications for licensure set out in this
28	chapter.
