- 13 FORWARD ENERGY, MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONAL SAVINGS. Any unexpended balance
- 14 of funds authorized in this Act for guaranteed energy, maintenance, and
- 15 operational savings generated through energy usage, solar power, waste
- 16 management, water conservation, and similar efficiency efforts on June 30
- 17 2022 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the
- 18 <u>fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. Any realized savings and expenditures</u>
- 19 shall be reported to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 20 Committee no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency

- 22 Committee. This authority authorizes the reinvestment of guaranteed savings
- 23 <u>for future and existing energy conservation projects.</u>

- 27 SECTION 47. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

- 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 6-51-
- 24 303, concerning the administration of multidistrict vocational centers, is
