22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State

20 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 22 HELP. No employee of the Camp J.T. Robinson, or Fort Chaffee Federal
 23 Training Site Divisions of the Military Department who is employed as "extra
 24 help" may receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the
 25 maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas
 26 Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be
 27 employed for a period of time to exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any
 28 single fiscal year.

32 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 34 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The State Military Department is hereby authorized to
 35 transfer appropriation from Operating Expenses to Promotional Items in the
 36 General Operations Appropriation and/or Cash Operations Appropriation

1 provided by this Act, promotional items, authorized by the Director of the
2 Department to meet requirements of the State Military Department.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
4 2015 through June 30, 2016.

5
6 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CAMP
8 ROBINSON - VARIOUS STATE MILITARY LAKES. The State Military Department is
9 hereby authorized to stock various State Military Lakes on Camp Robinson post
10 each year with fish for special events by using wildlife funds and rental
11 income, no State General Revenue will be used.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
13 2015 through June 30, 2016.

14
15 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

24
25 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
35 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
36 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
