Amend Senate Bill No. 97 as originally introduced:

Following Section 39, insert a new section:

"SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

NONTRADITIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AGGREGATE AMOUNT. Aggregate amounts of scholarships awarded to nontraditional students, under the provisions of the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2, ACA 6-85-201 et seq., for the 2015-16 fiscal year shall be limited to thirteen million dollars (\$13,000,000).

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016."

" SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MORO BAY FUND TRANSFER. The Department of Parks and Tourism shall transfer
the first fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) of revenue generated from the Moro Bay Cabins located at Moro Bay State Park to the Ouachita River
Waterways Project Trust Fund to be used exclusively for expenses associated with the Ouachita River Commission.
It is the intent of the General Assembly and shall be monitored by the
Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that the funding provided in this Section
shall not supplant any existing or budgeted revenues."
