"SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MORO BAY FUND TRANSFER. The Department of Parks and Tourism shall transfer the first fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) of revenue generated from the Moro Bay Cabins located at Moro Bay State Park to the Ouachita River Waterways Project Trust Fund to be used exclusively for expenses associated with the Ouachita River Commission. It is the intent of the General Assembly and shall be monitored by the
Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that the funding provided in this Section shall not supplant any existing or budgeted revenues."
