 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 31 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

" SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER. (a) Notwithstanding other provisions of law, from time to time, as balances are available, in the ADEQ Environmental Settlement Trust Fund, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, a sum not to exceed five million six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$5,650,000), from the ADEQ Environmental Settlement Trust Fund to the State Highway and Transportation Department Fund to provide funds to replace aging high-emitting vehicles and equipment with newer, cleaner vehicles and equipment.

11 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
13 INVESTMENTS. All funds that are held at any time in the Landfill Post-
14 Closure Trust Fund, Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund, and
15 Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund may be invested and reinvested, subject to
16 the written approval of the Office of the Treasurer, to the extent feasible,
17 and all investments as authorized for use by the Office of the Treasurer may
18 be available to the listed funds. The movement of these funds into and out
19 of investments shall be by fund transfers as directed by the Director of the
20 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017

24  SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
25 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
