





- Provide technology equipment across the district in order to fulfill the one to one initiative of the Paragould School District.
- Provide before/after school tutoring at Paragould Junior High and Paragould Senior High Schools.
- Provide ACT prep course during the summer for students wishing to improve their ACT scores.
- Provide online courseware that is built on real-world skills, based on blended learning best practices, and aligned to state and national standards.
- Provide mathematics, literacy, and science materials and supplies to supplement instruction for students.



- Provide common assessments to monitor student progress toward proficiency on state assessments in both literacy and math.
- Provide 6 school nurses (above the requirement).
- Provide eight classroom preschool aides.
- Provide three human service workers.
- Provide a math instructional facilitator.
- Provide a literacy instructional facilitator.
- Provide six school resource officers.


