Senator Hendren,

Please note that I am copying Reps. Carmine and Summers, and ADHE Interim Director Shane Broadway.

Northwest Arkansas Community College today began answering additional questions and completing requests we exclusively received this past month from the Bureau of Legislative Research on behalf of the chairs of the ALC Higher Education Subcommittee.

Background on those questions is supplied in the text boxes below. Please call me if I can provide further background.

Dr. Paneitz requests that you, as a member of this committee, ask Bureau staff to send out the following **SIX** questions and requests presented in italics below **TO ALL COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES** in time for review at the June 2012 ALC Higher Education Subcommittee meeting.

Dr. Paneitz requests also that you ask that this information be summarized by Bureau staff and be made available at the June ALC Higher Education Subcommittee meeting.

We understand how arduous to the institutions the process of completing these requests will be; our hardworking employees have devoted countless hours and thousands of dollars in lost employee productivity to researching, answering and completing these requests.

However, NWACC continues to be singled out by this subcommittee for special treatment. We ask that you make the following requests in an effort to “level the playing field” for the June ALC Higher Education Subcommittee

1. On Friday, April 6, the Bureau sent an additional request just for NWACC.

“Please ask them to tell us how many students they have dismissed over the last 5 years for non-academic reasons and the reason for the dismissal. By “dismissal” I mean expelled, forced out, kicked out, removed from class, etc. etc.”

NWACC completed this request.

2. On Friday, April 13, the Bureau sent an additional request just for NWACC.

“For all classified positions on the institution’s ‘raise list’ (personnel seeing raises since 7/1/11), provide a copy of all ads for classified (and non-classified, if any) positions and list where they were posted. Provide job specs for the new positions/raises for both classified and non-class.”

NWACC provided this list.

3. On Thursday, April 19, the Bureau sent an additional request just for NWACC on behalf of the Chairs of the ALC-Higher Education Subcommittee.

List employees whose salaries are paid wholly or partially by grant funds.

NWACC provided this list today, Friday, May 4.

4. On Thursday, April 19, the Bureau sent an additional request just for NWACC on behalf of the Chairs of the ALC-Higher Education Subcommittee.

List all bids received during the last 12 months with details of the bid projects/items.
