

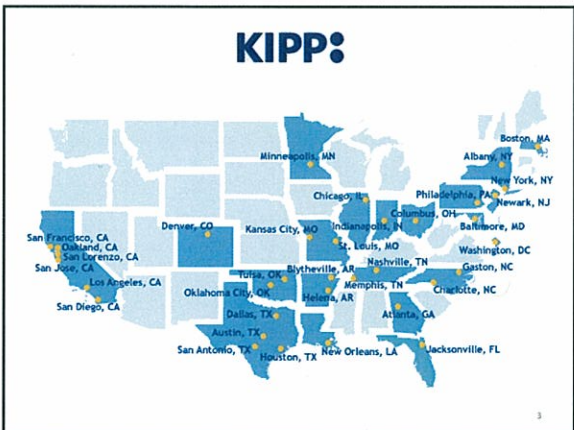

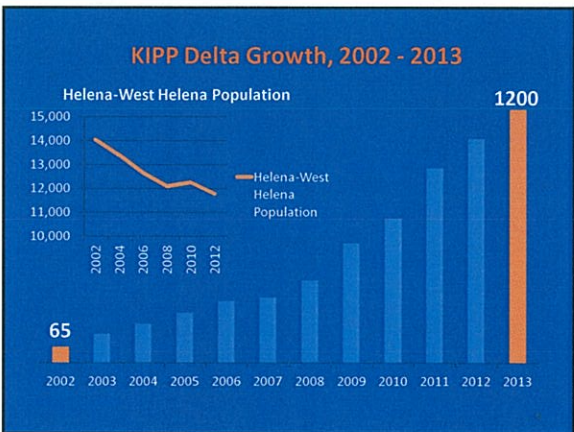


KIPP Delta Mission & Demographics

- 8% Receive Special Education Services



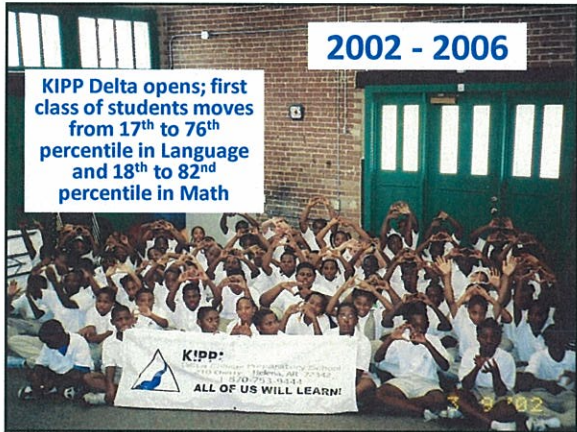
