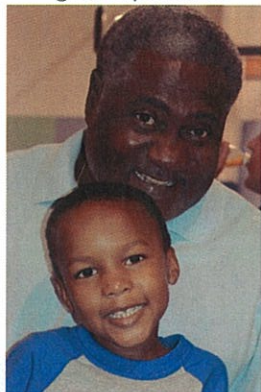

## Detention Point System

- Minor behavioral infractions are assigned numerical value
- Parental notification via database and app
- Accrual of so many points = Saturday Detention
- Deters misbehaviors
- More instructional time

## Positive Reinforcement Points

- Good deeds/ behavior assigned numerical value
- Parental notification via database and app
- Encourages positive behaviors/ atmosphere
- Rewards/ recognizes the good
- Reduces detention points

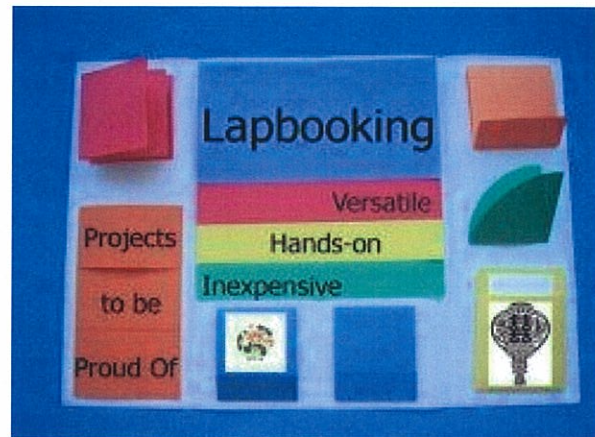

# MISSION

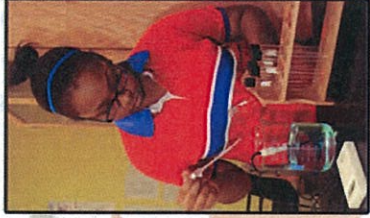

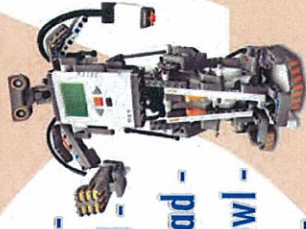

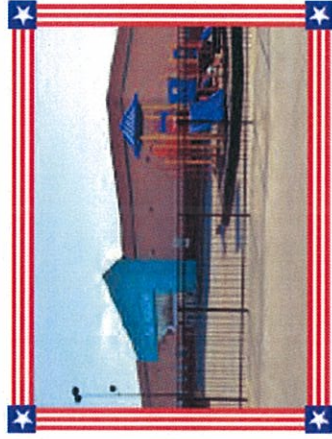
