The House Communications Office has prepared several materials and visuals to assist you in the classrooms. Everything is available on the website

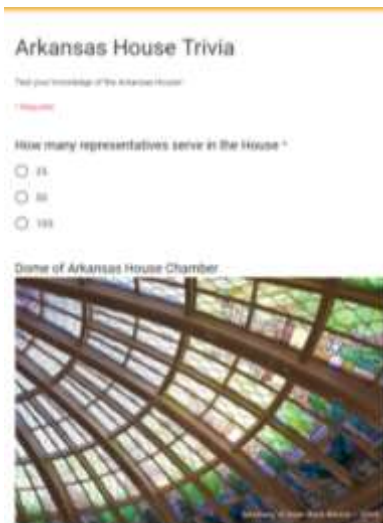

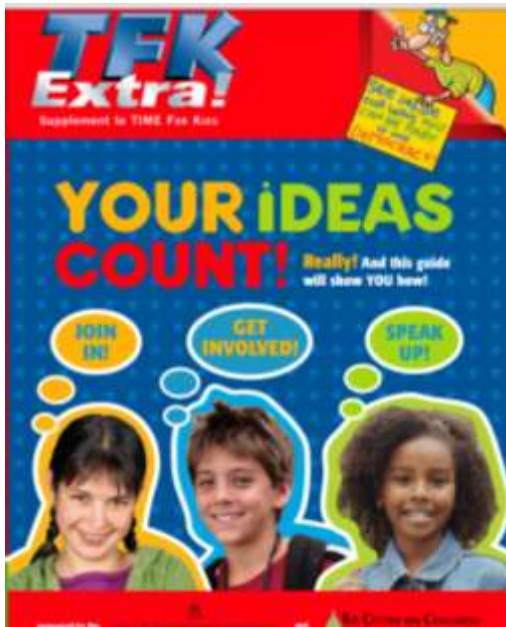
