

% earning four-year degrees*





Low-income Average KIPP



Central High School Class of 2013 4-year College/University Enrollment after High School Graduation



Central High School Class of 2015 4-year College/University Enrollment after High School Graduation





Cross County High School Class of 2014 Post-secondary Enrollment after High School Graduation



DCAN Senior Year Timeline


Fall
