BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Senate Interim Committee On Public  
Health, Welfare And Labor study the administration of programs aimed at  
improving minority health in this state, programs including the Minority  
Health Commission and other state agencies with responsibilities for  
protecting the health of Arkansans.
