 3. ISP 2013-125 by Representative Dotson – To amend the membership of the Board of Corrections.
 4. ISP 2013-153 By Representative Leding – To require state agencies to create a compensation equality policy; and to require state agencies to be transparent concerning equal compensation for equal services.
 5. ISP 2013-154 by Representative Leding – To encourage the efficient administration of state agencies; and to require state agencies to review old rules.
 6. ISP 2013-155 by Representative Leding – To provide increased accessibility to state government regulatory data; and to require the Secretary of State to create and maintain a database of regulatory data for each state agency.
 7. ISP 2013-156 by Representative Leding – To encourage oversight of state agencies; to require periodic review of all state agencies; to provide recommendations to state agencies to prevent waste.
