

## **Corrections in Arkansas**



The Arkansas Parole Board is an agency consisting of 22 employees (7 Commissioners, 3 Hearing Judges, and 12 Support Staff). The Board serves as both the parole and revocation authority for the State. The Board has the additional responsibility of making non-binding recommendations to the Governor regarding matters of Executive Clemency. The Chairman of the Board serves as a voting member of the Board of Corrections which oversees the Departments of Correction, Community Correction, and the Correctional School System.

## **Duties of the Arkansas Parole Board:**

- Consider the release, via parole, of inmates from the ADC or DCC
- Set conditions governing the release and supervision of parolees
- Consider revoking the parole of offenders who violate one (1) or more conditions of their supervision.
- Make non-binding recommendations to the Governor regarding Executive Clemency Applications
