To Name a Few:

...too few foster and adoptive families (low foster family retention and hundreds of families short of need)

...need to increase support for biological and foster families (low bio family reunification rates)

...DCFS is stretched too thin



Our Response

We formed *Every Child Arkansas* in response to these challenges.

Every Child Arkansas (ECA) is a network of advocates, agencies, faith-based organizations, and other organizations working together in trust-building collaboration to fill the biggest gaps in caring for children and families before, during, and beyond foster care in our state.






But many things are encouraging....

Our History and Plans

- Summer 2021 Began talking about collaborating for "more than enough" in Arkansas
- Fall 2021 Executive Leadership Counsel formed
- November 30, 2021 Kick off gathering for Pulaski County
- December 2021 Working groups launch
- January 2022 started discussions with The Contingent
- April 2022 Meetings with Arkansas Team, Contingent and DCFS
- April August 2022 Continued discussions and planning with Arkansas Network members and The Contingent



Our History and Plans

- Fall, 2022 continued work on coordinating ground-game and airgame activities
- December 11, 2022 Fund raising event with Chris Tomlin and Bart Millard (MercyMe)
- January 2023 Face-to-face meetings for teams addressing media relations and communications, training on ECA web portal, and "customer experience" process
- Late February/Early March 2023 Tentative date for the official "launch" of the statewide ECA initiative







- ✓ More Than Enough Foster Families in Top 25 Counties (Private Placement)
