3 REQUESTING THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND
4 LABOR CONDUCT AN INTERIM STUDY TO DETERMINE THE NEED FOR NEW
5 LICENSURE OF AN ASSISTANT PHYSICIAN.

7 WHEREAS, the healthcare system in the United States and the State of
8 Arkansas is vastly changing and growing; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas is experiencing a healthcare provider
11 shortage resulting in medically underserved areas; and
12

13 WHEREAS, the demand for healthcare services has outpaced the supply of
14 providers, particularly primary care providers; and
15

16 WHEREAS, Missouri recently enacted legislation that allowS a recent
17 medical school graduate who has passed medical examinations but who has not
18 entered into a postgraduate residency training to provide primary care
19 services to individuals in medically underserved areas; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the recently engaged Missouri legislation allowed these
22 medical school graduates to practice primary care services as licensed
23 assistant physicians; and

25 WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas does not have a registration,
26 certification, or licensure procedure for an assistant physician; and
27

28 WHEREAS, for the health of its citizens, the General Assembly should
29 pursue efforts to improve and increase access to healthcare by utilizing the
30 capacity of the recent medical school graduates,

32 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR OF
33 THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

1 THAT the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor conduct
2 an interim study to determine the need for new licensure of an assistant
3 physician.
