7 WHEREAS, a significant cause of infant mortality is premature delivery;
8 and

10 WHEREAS, maternal and newborn intensive care for very premature
11 deliveries and births has reduced mortality for those most at risk; and

13 WHEREAS, access to perinatal intensive care services is inconsistent in
14 Arkansas and this state lacks formal public policy to address the
15 inconsistencies,

17 NOW THEREFORE,

18 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR
19 OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 THAT the Senate Committee On Public Health, Welfare, And Labor study
22 the benefits of:

23 (1) A classification system of Arkansas hospitals' neonatal
24 intensive care units as proposed by the NICU Classification Committee and
25 recommended by the State Board of Health; and

26 (2) The most optimal medical delivery system to provide risk
27 risk-appropriate medical care to reduce maternal and infant morbidity and
28 mortality and to provide the most effective and efficient high-quality care
29 to the mothers and babies of this state.
