This short-term solution is easy and inexpensive and can help stop completely preventable injuries and deaths.

## **Long-term Solution – Promote Goals Designed to Maximize Safety**

In their current design, soccer goals can weigh up to 400 pounds and are top-heavy because the bars are made of metal. While anchoring unsafe goals goes a long way to prevent incidents, the ultimate answer is to revamp soccer goals, using lighter materials and tip-resistant design. A new ASTM standard for tip-resistant soccer goal (F2673-08) has recently been released and can be found at <a href="mailto:astm.org">astm.org</a>. One such design that meets this standard is described here: <a href="Mew Stable Goal Design">New Stable Goal Design</a>
