




## Teen Birth Rates Arkansas and U.S.




## Teen Birth Rates By Year And Maternal Age




## Teen Birth Rates 15-19 Years By Maternal Race and Ethnicity




#### Teens Birth Rates 18-19 Years By Maternal Race and Ethnicity




#### Teens Birth Rates 15-17 Years By Maternal Race and Ethnicity




## Teen Birth Rates Among White, Non-Hispanics Arkansas and U.S.




