HB2587	Pace	AN ACT CONCERNING THE POSTING OF SIGNS ON CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAYS AND CONTROLLED-ACCESS FACILITIES FOR NOTIFICATION THAT THE LEFT LANE IS FOR PASSING ONLY.
HB2589	Pace	TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR IMPEDING THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC ON CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAYS AND CONTROLLED-ACCESS FACILITIES AND TO DIRECT THE REMITTANCE AND USE OF THE INCREASED FINE.
HB2609	Harris	TO REQUIRE THAT NOTIFICATION OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS INCLUDE THAT NO VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWAL WILL BE ISSUED TO ANY PERSON WHO HAS AN OUTSTANDING WARRANT FOR HIS OR HER ARREST.
HB2766	King	TO CREATE THE HIGHWAY MEMORIAL SAFETY PROGRAM TO IMPROVE THE WARNING FOR DANGEROUS AREAS OF THE HIGHWAY AND PROVIDE A MEMORIAL TO PERSONS WHO HAVE DIED AS A RESULT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT AT THAT LOCATION.
HB2796	J. Roebuck	AN ACT TO INCREASE DRIVER LICENSE RENEWAL FEES TO FUND THE ARKANSAS ANTI- LITTER FUND.
HB2799	J. Roebuck	AN ACT TO INCREASE ANNUAL LICENSE PLATE VALIDATION DECAL FEES TO FUND THE ARKANSAS ANTI-LITTER FUND.
