

Division of Youth Services Arkansas Child Welfare Report Card In Compliance with Act 1222 of 1995 Report Period July 2012 – June 2013



Executive Summary

For FY 2013 the age and gender of committed juvenile offenders remained overwhelmingly males between 15 and 17 years of age. In FY 2013 there was less than a 1% decrease in Caucasian youth and a 9% decrease in African-American youth committed to DYS. In FY 2013 the number of youth recommitted to DYS in percentage points remained the same and the number of youth committed for felony type offenses decreased by 34%. The high percentage of decrease is due to a changed in reporting. Starting mid October 2012, DYS is now able to more accurately denote the youth committed for revocation of probation, probation violations, and aftercare violations. The number of commitments to DYS from FY 2010 through FY 2013 averaged around 494 annually. In FY 2013 the number of commitments decreased by 5.6% from the prior year.





Chart 1: Commitments

Comparison of the Fiscal Years





Chart 3: Commitments by Offense* For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period




Chart 5: Commitments by Race For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period




Chart 6: Commitments by Race Comparison of the Fiscal Years




Chart 7: Commitments by Gender For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period




Chart 8: Commitments by Gender Comparison of the Fiscal Years




Chart 9: Commitments by Age For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period




Chart 10: Offenses by Age
For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Quarter




Chart 11: Commitments by Age Comparison of the Fiscal Years




Chart 12: Number of Males Committed by Offense For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period






Chart 13: Number of Females Committed by Offense For Juveniles Committed During Reporting Period




Chart 15: Total Population by Program Type




Profiles of Juveniles Committed July 2012 - June 2013

^{*} Since the Hotline and the Investigations units are two separate sections within the Arkansas State Police, the Hotline may accept an incident called in, then later the incident will not be investigated by the Investigations Unit after review of the circumstances. The DYS IAU never receives a follow-up on these reports to know whether they were ever investigated. Some of these incidents occurred prior to the juvenile being committed to DYS. The IAU does not receive notification of the findings in these incidents. Some incidents that are reported in one quarter may not be finalized by the State Police until sometime within the next quarter.

Chart 19: Categories of Cases Accepted




Chart 20: Status of Cases Accepted

Chart 21: Incidents Reports for FY 2013





Chart 22: Incidents Reported to Hotline for FY 2013
