INTRODUCTION

The 2005 Regular Session of the 85th General Assembly of the Arkansas Legislature expanded the legal definition of child neglect in the State of Arkansas. Under the provisions of Act 1176, the term neglect was expanded to include “the causing of a newborn child to be born with:

- 1) an illegal substance present in the newborn’s bodily fluids or bodily substances as a result of the pregnant mother knowingly using an illegal substance before the birth of the newborn, or
- 2) a health problem as a result of the pregnant mother’s use before birth of an illegal substance.”

Garrett’s Law, which was named after a newborn child who was born under such circumstances, was modified by Act 284 of the 2007 Legislative Session. The “health problem” criterion was eliminated but was replaced by the criterion of “the presence of an illegal substance in the mother’s bodily fluids or bodily substances.” As a result of this change (which went into effect on July 1, 2007), the presence of an illegal substance, which includes the abuse of prescription drugs, in either the newborn or the mother is now sufficient to substantiate an allegation of neglect under Garrett’s Law. Another significant change made by Act 284 was that even if a Garrett’s Law referral was substantiated, the mother would not be listed in the state’s Child Maltreatment Registry. This change was made in response to concerns that being listed in the Maltreatment Registry might have negative consequences for the employment prospects of mothers involved in substantiated referrals.

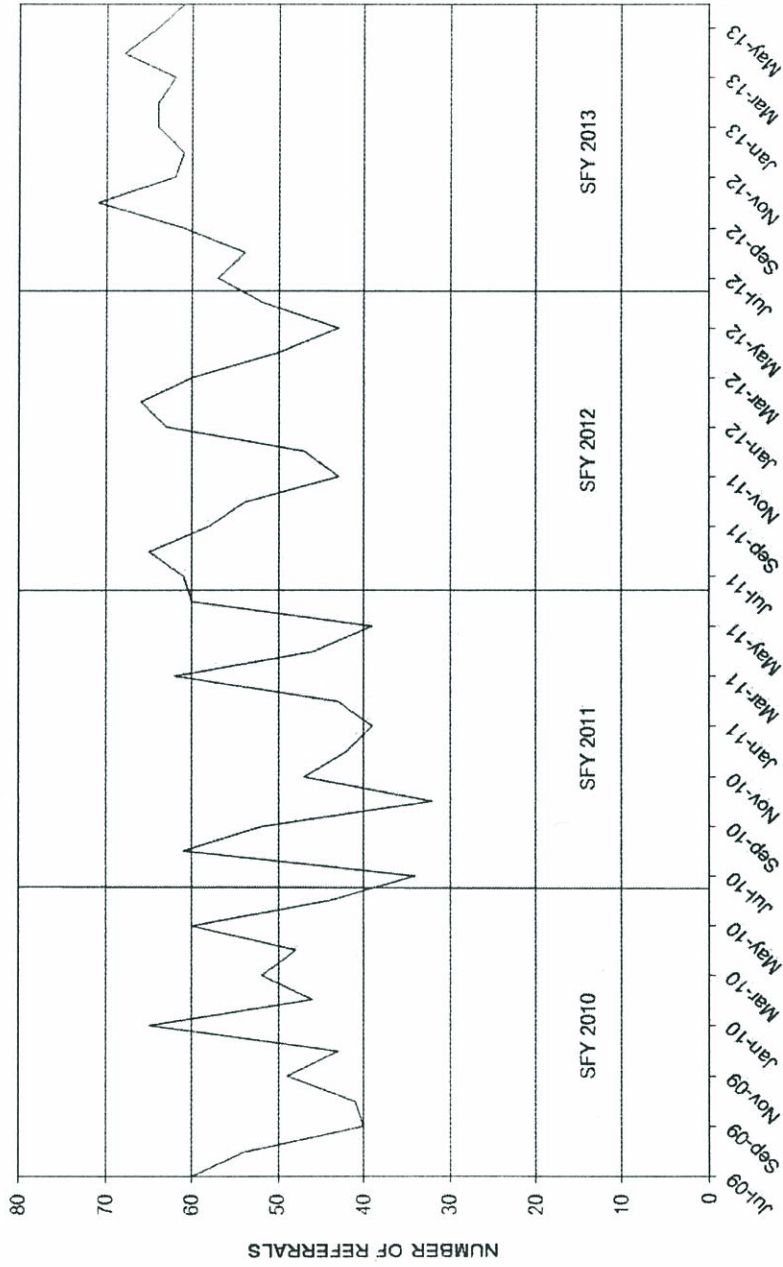
This report presents information on Garrett’s Law referrals received during State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2013. As in previous years’ reports, the data for 2013 are shown in the context of comparable data from the preceding three fiscal years. Additionally, this report will track whether the mothers cited in true referrals receive specialized treatment through one of the licensed substance abuse treatment facilities that accept clients throughout the state. These facilities, which offer both outpatient and inpatient programs, are available for the mothers cited in these referrals.

GARRETT'S LAW REFERRALS RECEIVED

Seven-hundred and forty-nine (749) Garrett's Law (GL) referrals were received by the state's Child Abuse Hotline during SFY 2013. This represents a 13 percent increase over the 662 referrals received during SFY 2012 and a 34 percent increase over the 557 referrals received during SFY 2011. Six-hundred and two (602) GL referrals were received during SFY 2010.

Figure 1 shows the number of GL referrals received each month during the four-year period from SFY 2010 through 2013. With the exception of SFY 2011, the number of GL referrals received monthly has generally increased over this period.

CHARACTERISTICS OF GARRETT'S LAW REFERRALS

Act 1176 requires that an annual report be made to the Legislature that includes the following characteristics of GL referrals:

- 1) the ages of mothers involved in the referrals,
- 2) the types of illegal substances to which the newborns were exposed,
- 3) the estimated gestational ages of the newborns, and
- 4) any health problems observed in the newborns.

Although there are some year-to-year fluctuations in the age distribution of mothers involved in GL referrals, mothers are generally less than 30 years old at the time of the child's birth. For SFY 2013, approximately 38 percent of the mothers who were involved in GL referrals were between the ages of 20 and 24, similar to previous years (see Table 1).

Table 2 shows the types of drugs involved in GL referrals during the past four fiscal years. First and foremost, marijuana (including THC and cannabis) represents by far the most commonly mentioned drug across all four years. For SFY 2013, it was cited in nearly two-thirds (64 percent) of the GL referrals.

Amphetamines (include "meth") were the second most commonly mentioned drug, identified in a quarter (25 percent) of the GL referrals received during SFY 2013. Amphetamines were cited far more frequently than was the case in prior years.

Opiates (e.g., morphine, codeine, and oxycodone) were cited in approximately 20 percent of GL referrals in each of the past four years. Meanwhile, benzodiazepines (e.g., prescription drugs such as Xanax and Valium) were identified in 11 percent of GL referrals during SFY 2013, similar to previous years. And finally, cocaine (including "crack") was mentioned in just seven percent of the referrals during the year, below the frequency at which it was cited in prior years.

Table 3 shows the gestational ages of newborns in GL referrals over the past four years. Despite slight year-to-year fluctuations, full-term births made up approximately two-thirds of all births.

Roughly 60 percent of the newborns do not have reported health problems, a finding which remains consistent from previous years. When health problems are explicitly documented, respiratory distress is the most common of the health concerns. Eight percent of the newborns suffered from respiratory distress or other respiratory problems for SFY 2013, similar to the percentage of children reported during previous years. Six percent exhibited explicit drug-related symptoms during the year, and four percent required intensive care; both of these figures were higher than in previous years.

² "Respiratory Distress" was not included as a separate category for SFY 2011. For SFY 2011, instances of "respiratory distress" were included under the category of "All Other."

³ "All Other" includes a wide range of observed health issues that could not be categorized elsewhere, including conditions such as low birth weight, low blood sugar, low heart rate, heart murmur, congenital heart defect, anemia, bandemia, feeding problems, intubated, hypoglycemia, syphilis, and a need for antibiotics

DCFS RESPONSES TO GARRETT'S LAW REFERRALS

This section presents information on key results stemming from DCFS responses to GL referrals, including:

- 1) the percentage of referrals that are substantiated after an investigation,
- 2) the percentage of true referrals that result in the opening of a child protective services case,⁴ and
- 3) the percentage of true referrals that result in the removal of the newborn from the mother's custody.

Results are presented for the ten DCFS Service Areas for each of the past four state fiscal years.

As shown in Table 5, the overwhelming majority of GL referrals were substantiated. Nearly 87 percent of all incoming GL referrals were found to be true between SFYs 2010 and 2013, with the substantiation rate gradually increasing each year. For SFY 2013, 92 percent of the GL referrals received statewide were substantiated.

⁴ Child protective services cases include both in-home cases in which children remain in the home and out-of-home placements in which children are placed with relatives or in foster care.

Table 6 shows the percentage of substantiated GL referrals that resulted in the opening of a child protective services case.⁵

Statewide, the rate at which DCFS caseworkers opened a child protective services case in response to a true finding of a GL referral stood at 95 percent for SFY 2013, up several percentage points from the rates at which cases had opened during the previous three years.

Whether or not caseworkers respond to a substantiated GL referral by opening a child protective services case was largely consistent among most DCFS Service Areas. Staff in eight of the ten areas opened cases for at least 95 percent of their true GL referrals. The lowest rate of case openings in response to a true report was observed in Area 1.

⁵ In addition to child protective services cases that opened as a result of the GL referral, the percentages also include cases that opened prior to the referral and were still open at the time of the referral. Considered together, these provide a more accurate representation of the percentage of substantiated GL referrals that were handled within the context of an active child protective services case.

Table 7 shows the percentage of substantiated GL referrals which resulted in the removal of the newborn from the mother's custody.

The statewide rate at which the newborns were removed from their mothers has hovered between 20 and 25 percent over the past four years, with significant variation in removal rates across the DCFS Service Areas. For SFY 2013, Areas 8 and 10 were less likely to remove children from their homes in response to a true GL referral. Meanwhile, the highest proportion of children who were removed from their homes after a true GL report occurred in Area 7 (43 percent). Area 7 was also among the most likely areas to open a child protective services case in response to a true report.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT

Mothers involved in GL referrals may subsequently be referred to specialized substance abuse treatment programs at one of the various sites scattered throughout the state. These treatment resources consist of both outpatient and inpatient programs. As Arkansas's authorized licensing agent for substance abuse treatment providers, the Office of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention (OADAP) of the Division of Behavioral Health Services maintains a comprehensive listing of licensed treatment facilities throughout the state.

As part of the conditions of licensure, these treatment facilities supply OADAP with monthly listings of the treatment services they have provided and the clients they have served. These listings include identifying information of the individuals who received those services, which permits matching of the mothers identified in GL referrals to the information housed at OADAP to see if any of these mothers received treatment through a licensed program.⁶

Overall, just over 20 percent of the mothers cited in true GL referrals over the past four years received some type of treatment service from an OADAP-licensed program (see Table 8). The percentage of mothers who have received such treatment has seemingly decreased since SFY 2010. Almost 30 percent of the mothers cited in GL referrals from SFY 2010 had received services, but just 11 percent of mothers cited in such referrals for SFY 2013 had participated in such treatment; however, sufficient time has not passed to fully identify all of those who will eventually receive treatment (this is especially true for those whose investigations occurred during SFY 2013).⁷

⁶ Only substance abuse treatment received by the mothers after the referral came in were counted. Any participation in substance abuse treatment received prior to the GL referral did not count as treatment in response to the referral.

⁷ Treatment data was not available past August 31, 2013 for this report. As has been the case in previous reporting years, many more of the mothers cited in GL referrals are projected to enter a treatment program after this date.

In addition to displaying the overall percentage of mothers cited in true GL referrals who subsequently received specialized substance abuse treatment, Table 8 also reports the proportion of mothers that received such treatment within six months of the referral. Among those who received specialized substance abuse treatment, the proportion of mothers who received treatment within six months of their involvement in a true GL referral has slowly increased over the past four years, from just over half (53 percent) for SFY 2010 to well over two-thirds (69 percent) for SFY 2012.⁸ These numbers suggest that mothers who receive treatment are beginning to participate in such treatment programs sooner than was the case previously.

The type(s) of treatment received by the mothers involved in true GL referrals is also recorded by OADAP. The five basic types are detoxification, outpatient treatment, partial day treatment, prison-based treatment, and residential treatment. As shown in Table 9, residential treatment was the most common service received by these mothers, with 38 percent receiving the service for some length of time. Outpatient treatment was also very popular, with 35 percent of mothers participating in the service.

⁸ Thus far for SFY 2013, nearly all of the mothers who received treatment had received services within the first six months of the GL referral, although not enough time has passed to say this with absolute certainty.

SUMMARY

This report reviewed select characteristics of Garrett's Law referrals and DCFS' responses to these referrals over the past four fiscal years. The highlights of this review are presented below.

- Over the past four years, the number of GL referrals received annually by the Child Abuse Hotline has increased. During SFY 2013, the hotline received 749 GL referrals.
- Across all four years, marijuana was, by far, the most commonly mentioned illegal substance in GL referrals. For SFY 2013, 64 percent involved marijuana, either separately or in combination with other drugs. Amphetamines (25 percent) and opiates (20 percent) were the next most commonly cited drugs. Benzodiazepines (such as "Xanax" and "Valium") were cited in 11 percent of referrals, while cocaine (including "crack") was cited in seven percent. Over the past four years, the prevalence of amphetamines among these referrals has increased while cocaine's has declined.
- Nearly 87 percent of the GL referrals were substantiated between SFYs 2010 and 2013. For SFY 2013, 92 percent of the GL referrals received were substantiated.
- Approximately 90 percent of the substantiated GL referrals between SFYs 2010 and 2013 resulted in the opening of a child protective services case. For SFY 2013, 95 percent of substantiated GL referrals led to a case opening, an increase over each of the past three years.
- Approximately 23 percent of the substantiated GL referrals received over the past four years resulted in the removal of the newborn. For SFY 2013, 25 percent of substantiated GL referrals led to the newborn's removal.
- Approximately one out of every five (20 percent) mothers who were cited in a true GL referral received substance abuse treatment through one of the state's licensed substance abuse programs over the past four years. The most common type of service received by these mothers was residential treatment, followed closely by outpatient treatment.
