
The Crimes Against Children Division of the Arkansas State Police administers the Child Abuse Hotline and the CACD Investigations Unit in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated §12-8-501.

Child Abuse Hotline

The Hot Line Unit, which operates 24-hours a day, 7-days a week, is authorized one (1) Division Commander, one (1) Administrator four (4) Supervisors and twenty seven (27) Hotline Operators. This unit operated with an average of 24 operators during the year.

Child Abuse Hot Line operators in the Crimes Against Children Division (CACD) of the Arkansas State Police received 63,553 reports in the year 2014. Of these reports, 31,110 were accepted as legally valid allegations of abuse or neglect. They were assigned for investigation to CACD investigators or to the Arkansas Department of Human Services' (DHS) Division of Children and Family Services (DCFS).

The chart below reflects the total number of calls received and the total number of calls legally accepted for investigation within the last 5 years.



The following chart represents the breakdown of calls received by the Hot Line in 2014.


The reports accepted by the Hot Line are divided into Priority One and Priority Two categories for investigation. Priority One reports are sent to the CACD Investigations Unit for investigation. CACD adds Priority Two allegations to their investigations if warranted. There can be multiple allegations investigated during the course of one investigation.

CACD Investigation Unit

The Investigations Unit is authorized one (1) Division Commander, one (1) Investigations Administrator, ten (10) Area Supervisors and sixty-three (63) Investigators. This section operated with an average of sixty-three (63) investigators during the year.

CACD Investigations Unit received 5,797 severe abuse cases for investigation in 2014. These reports include for example: child deaths, allegations of sexual abuse, physical abuse, head trauma, burns and abandonment.

Number of Investigations Assigned



The Investigations Unit investigated 17,480 total allegations as a result of the 5,797 investigations. Seventy-two percent of the Priority One allegations involved sexually related offenses.

CACD investigators closed 5,496 cases in 2014. Of the closed cases, 2,241 (41%) were found to be 'true'. This is well above the national average of 28%.

The investigative determination of 'true' means there was a preponderance of evidence that indicated the allegation(s) was true. An 'unsubstantiated' finding means the evidence was insufficient to support the allegation(s). Investigations closed with a determination of 'true' were reported to the appropriate prosecuting attorney.

The CACD Investigations Unit is evaluated on six performance indicators of compliance with Angela R. requirements, which were spelled out in a consent decree in the 1990s during federal court proceedings. They also are a part of an agreement between CACD and DHS.


The indicators are:

- The alleged victim(s) in Priority I reports is seen by the investigator within 24 hours.
- The alleged victim(s) in Priority II reports is seen by the investigator within 72 hours.
- All children in the home are seen during the investigation.
- The alleged victim(s) is interviewed (or observed) outside the presence of the alleged offender.
- 5. Parents/caretakers are interviewed in all investigations.
- 6. Investigations are concluded within 30 days of receipt of the allegation.


Effective August 16, 2013, Act 426 of 2013 extended the time for which investigations are to be concluded to 45 days.

By agreement with DHS, CACD is required to meet a minimum of 85% compliance in each performance indicator. The following chart shows the average compliance for the year 2014. The line numbers above are used as identifiers.
