- Description of Child Safety Centers that meet the requirements of and receive funding from the Commission or its designee.

A Child Safety Center (CSC) is a not-for-profit child-friendly facility that provides a location and/or access to forensic interviews, specialized medical examinations, child and family advocacy and trauma-focused mental health services, among others, during the course of a child maltreatment investigation. It provides a coordinated, collaborative and culturally competent Multi-Disciplinary Team response to allegations of child abuse.

- The incidence of child abuse based on information obtained from Child Safety Centers.

CSCs collect and maintain data which reflects the number of children seen and services provided. These numbers are inclusive only of those children seen at one of the fourteen primary CSCs or one of the four satellite centers and do not reflect the number of instances of abuse statewide.

- Number of children receiving services at all CSCs sites.

The number of children seen during fiscal year 2015 – 2016 at all CSCs is 5422.

Among services received by these children and their families would be forensic interviews, medical exams, advocacy services and therapy.

- Outcome data provided by the Child Safety Centers.

Collected data specifically reflects assessed needs of the child and responsive services provided. Data collected and reported relate more to process variables.

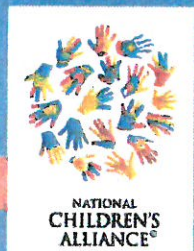
