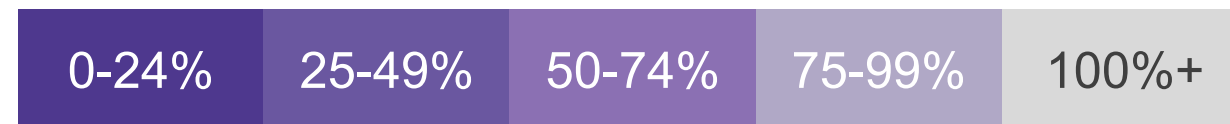
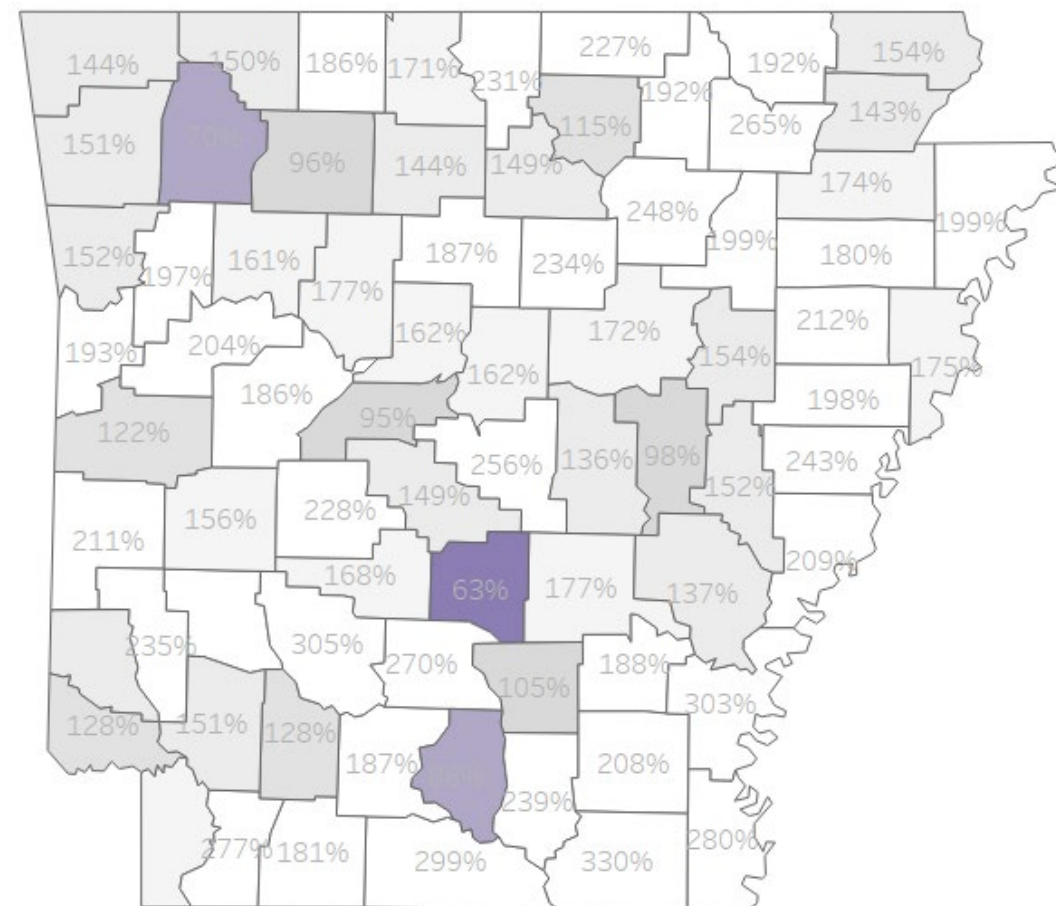


The supply of care for Pre-K children is higher than demand in most counties.

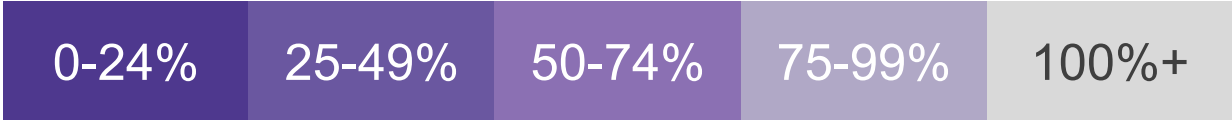
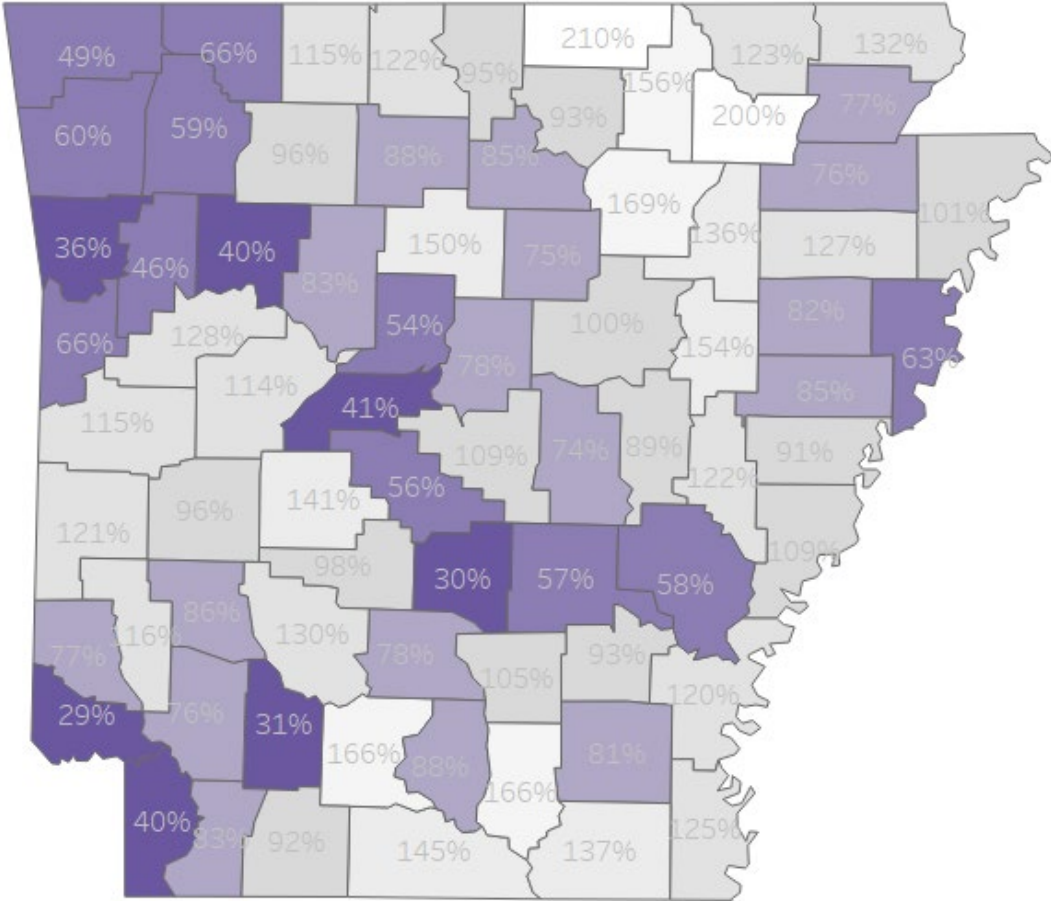
The overall median demand met is 177%.



When you consider only high-quality programs (Lv3BB), Pre-K supply & demand are near evenly matched in most counties.

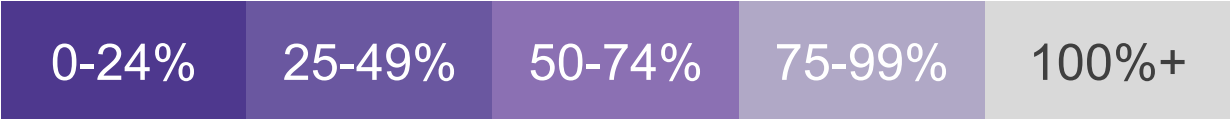
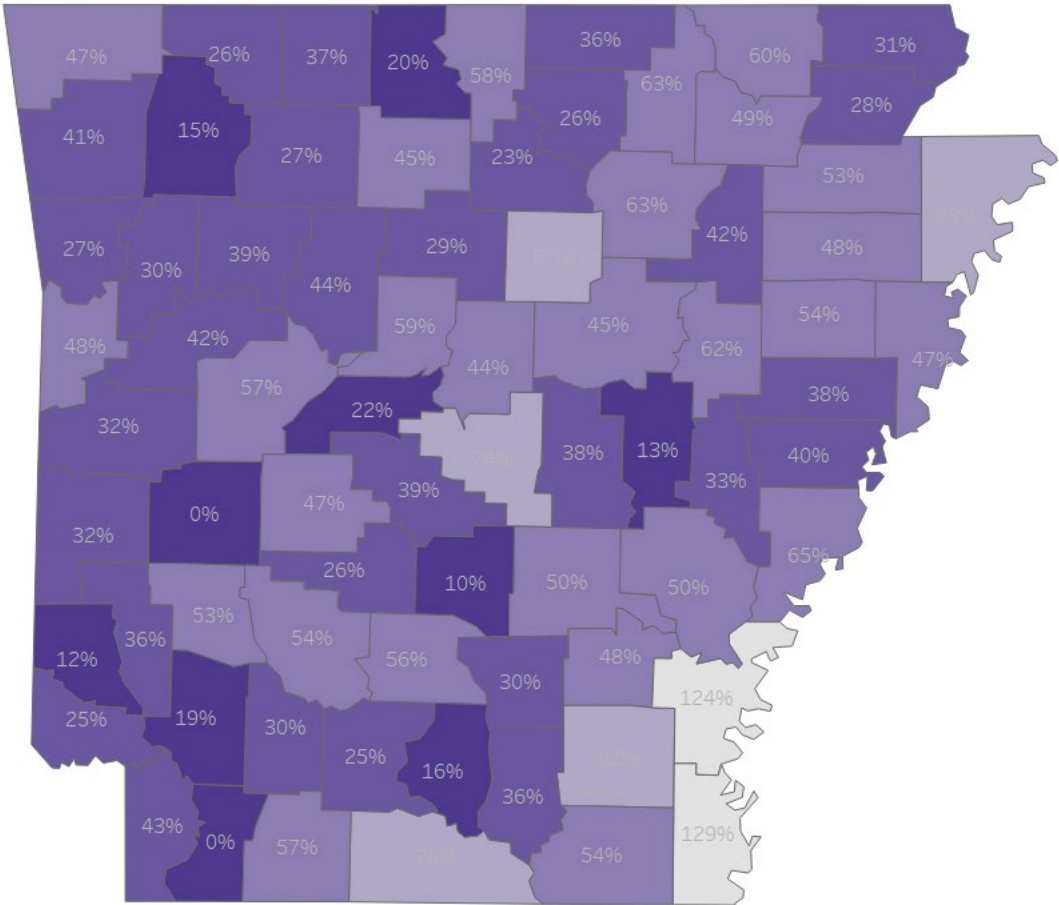
But some counties have significant unmet demand.
