32,000 acres approximately



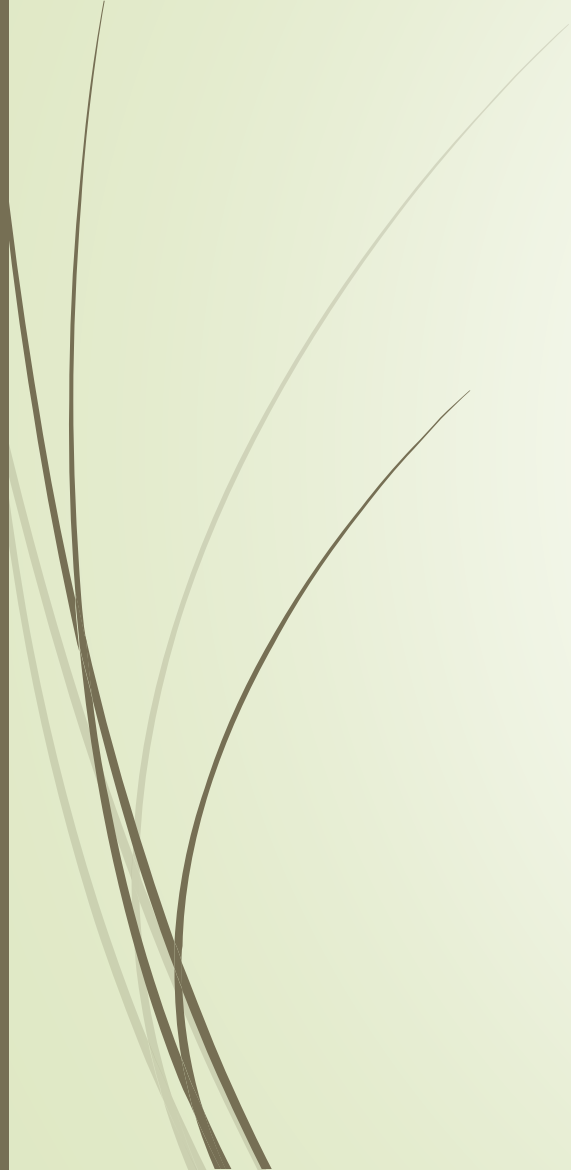
General Recommendations

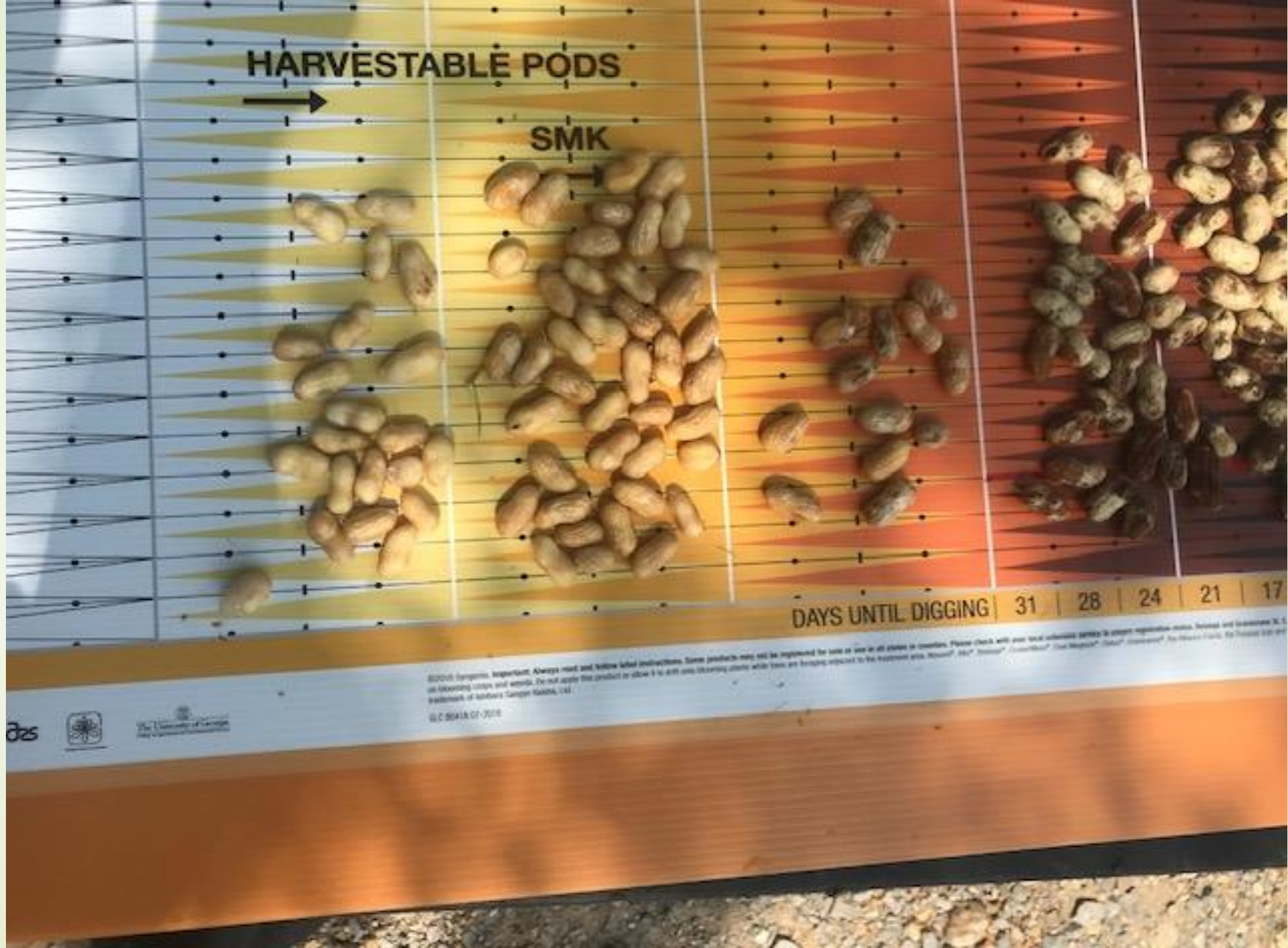
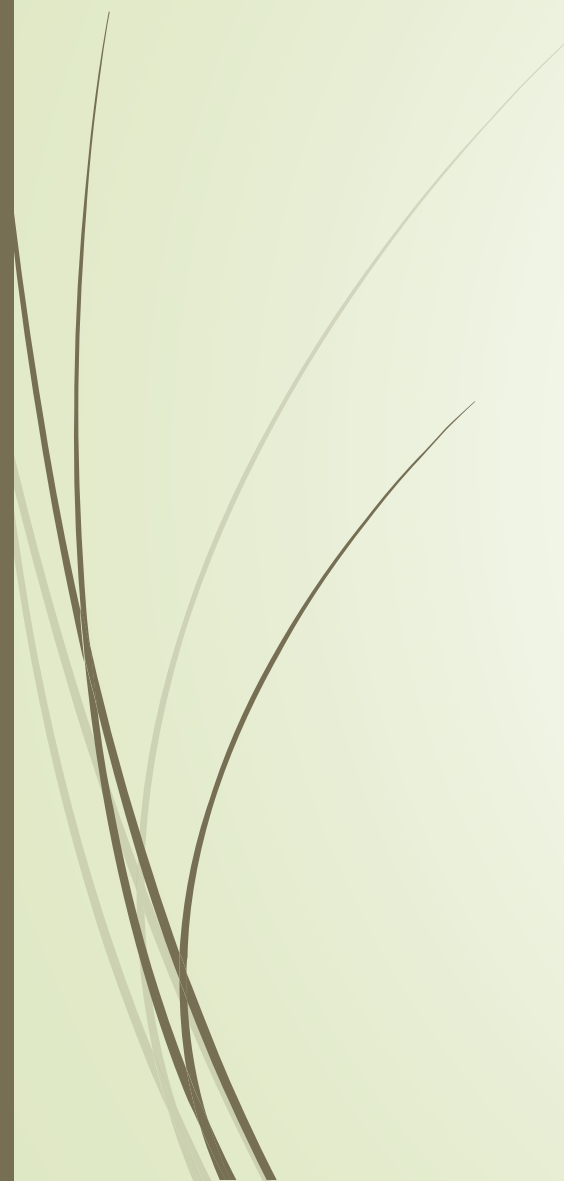
- Planting dates = Late April to Mid May (140 day season)
- Preferred Soil Types = Sandy to Sandy Loam
- Plant Proven Varieties – Standard VS High Oleic
- Use a quality inoculant
- Have a Fungicide Program
- Match Equipment Needs to Acreage Planted





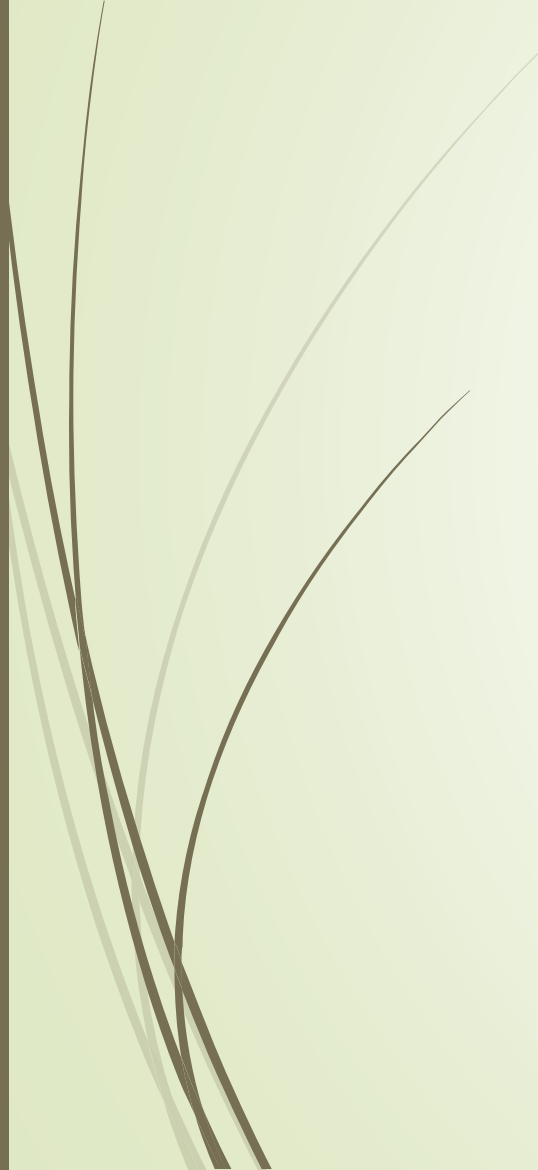








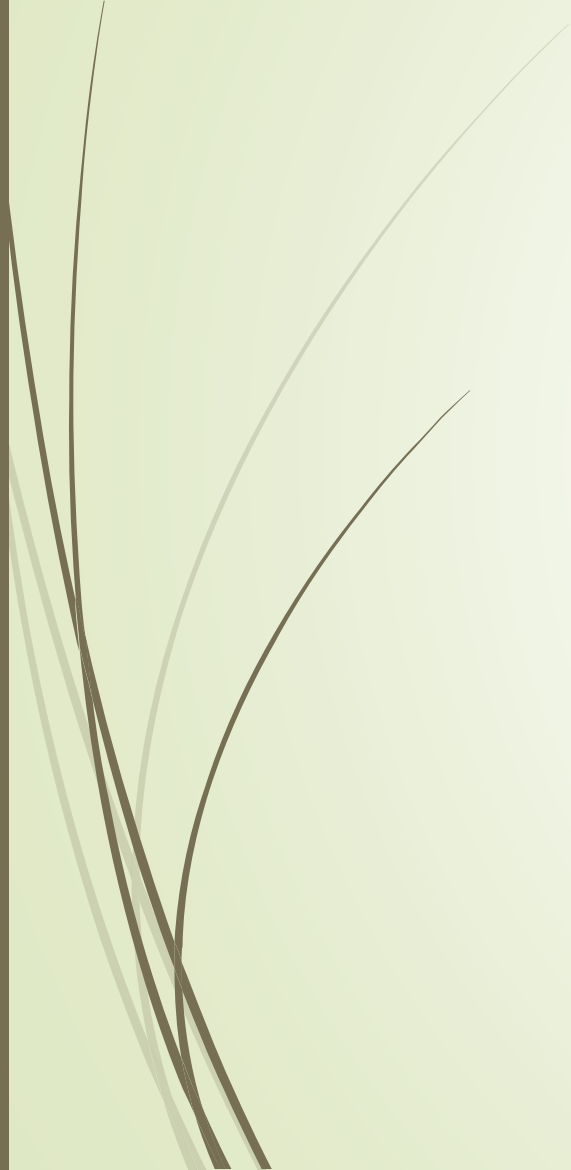
Equipment Needs

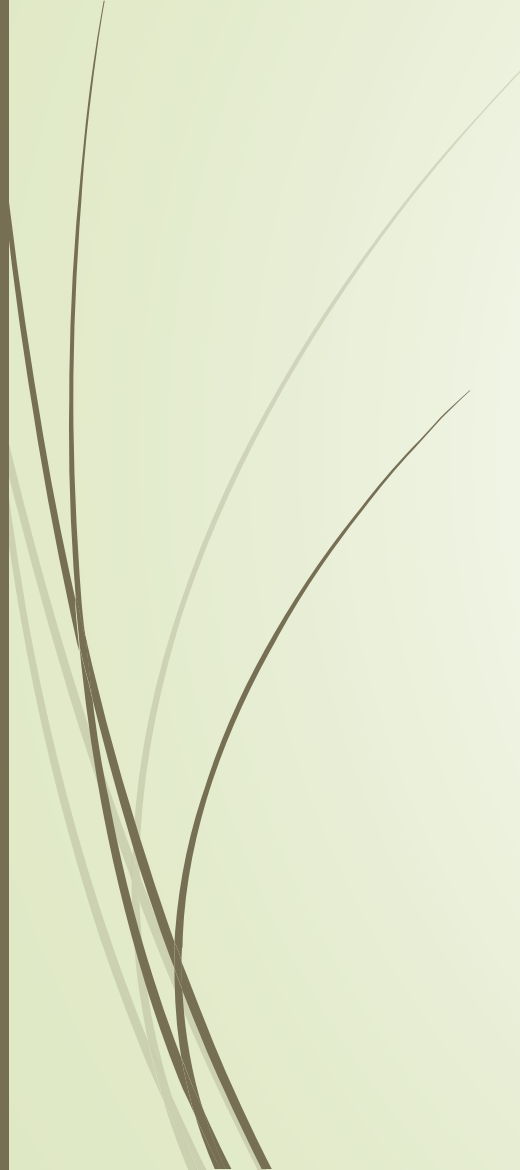


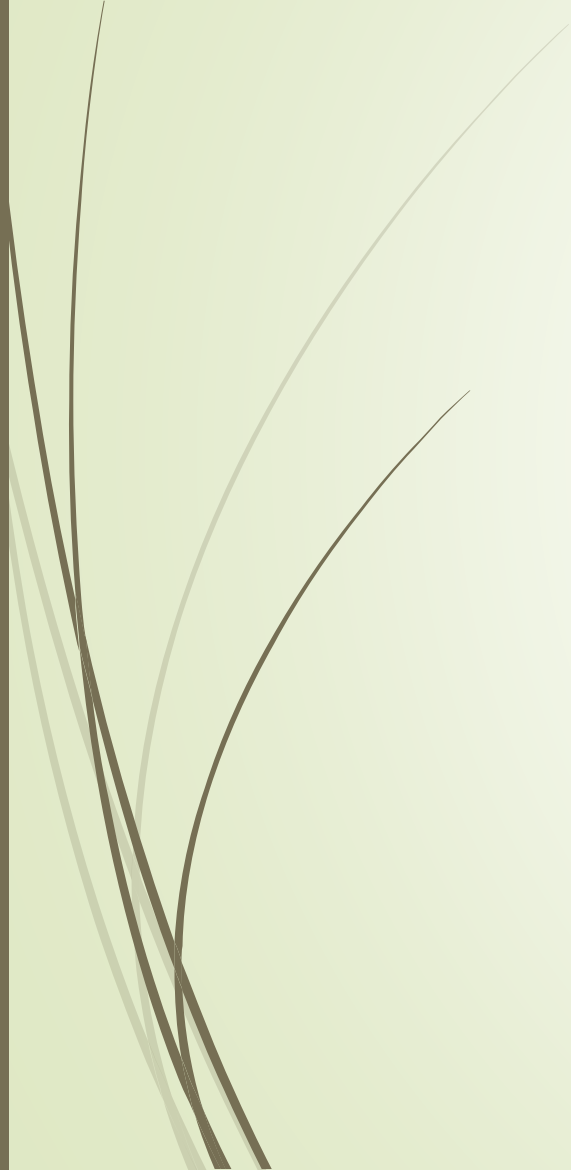
















2019 Average Yields, Price and Production Costs

Average Yield & Price

- 5000 lbs. per acre plus
- Some yields reach 7000 lbs.
- Loan Price = \$355.00 per ton
- Avg. Price Received \$400 per ton

Average Production Costs

- Range from \$450 to \$650 per acre
- Dryland vs Irrigated
- Varies from Producer to Producer depending on harvest equipment age and type



Extension's Role in 2020

- Purchase Weigh Wagon to Provide Measurable Results
- Conduct Research – Varieties, Fertility, etc.
- Conduct Production Meetings and In – Season IPM Meetings
- Work Closely With Producers, Consultants
- Provide Agronomic Advice
