### LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY COMMISSION

**SUBJECT:** Laboratory/Regulatory Fee Schedule

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission Veterinary Diagnostic Lab is revising their fee structure in an attempt to more closely cover their costs of operation. The fee structure has remained unchanged since 2008 and during that time period, the cost of supplies and materials needed to perform diagnostic testing have increased dramatically.

All fees charged for each procedure performed by the lab were considered for revision and the great majority have been raised. This action should stop or lessen the decline in fund balances experienced over the last couple of years and allow the commission to remain competitive and viable as a reliable and effective source of diagnostic testing for the veterinarians and other users in the State.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** A public hearing was held on September 25, 2013. The public comment period expired on October 9, 2013. The following comment was received from Mary Cameron, Bureau of Legislative Research:

Comment: I am having trouble reconciling A.C.A. § 2-33-111 that allows the Commission to set the fee structure on diagnostic services (no limits stated) and A.C.A. § 2-33-115(a)(1) which sets a fee of \$2.00 per head collected on all private-ownership cow tests in the state.

Response: A.C.A. § 2-33-111 deals with fees for "diagnostic lab" services. All but the last page of our fee structure regulation deals with the "diagnostic lab". A.C.A. § 2-33-115 deals with tests by our field inspectors for various diseases or are strictly regulatory in nature. A.C.A. § 2-40-1201 deals with the pseudorabies fees and A.C.A. § 2-40-206 deals with brucellosis fees. These tests are unrelated to our "diagnostic lab" work.

The effective date of this rule is thirty (30) days after filing of the final rule.

**CONTROVERSY:** This is not expected to be controversial.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The costs to the regulated parties cannot be estimated as the number and type of test for any particular customer is an unknown variable. The commission estimates that the total increase in agency revenue may not exceed \$100,000. No additional cost should be incurred by the agency.

**LEGAL AUTHORIZATION:** The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission ("Commission") is authorized to promulgate rules establishing a fee structure for services performed by its diagnostic laboratories on livestock and poultry (Ark. Code Ann. § 2-33-111) and small animals (Ark. Code Ann. § 2-33-112).
