<u>SB290</u>	C. Penzo	TO PROVIDE FOR A TEMPORARY INCREASE IN THE COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR ELECTED COUNTY OFFICERS AND JUSTICES OF THE PEACE.
<u>HB1528</u>	B. McKenzie	TO REQUIRE A BALLOT MEASURE BEFORE A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CAN BE CREATED; AND TO REQUIRE THAT THE VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY IN THE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT MATCH THE VALUE AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ASSESSOR.
<u>HB1541</u>	Jean	TO INCREASE AMOUNTS PAID BY QUORUM COURTS FOR THE CONTINUING EDUCATION OF COUNTY OFFICIALS; AND TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX REVENUE DISTRIBUTED FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION OF COUNTY OFFICIALS.
