Current Challenges to Lowering Volunteer Fire Department ISO Ratings

- Declining volunteer Base
- Overworked volunteer Base (present and future)
- Collection rates
- Obstacles to Improving Collections
- Statewide plan to lower ISO Rates by a targeted date and sufficient manpower
- Changes in the ISO Rating System
- Specify that funding provided must be spent on lowering a department's ISO rating
- The ability to identify efficient methods/processes to overcome obstacles to fire rating improvements.
