 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE'S CONTRIBUTIONS. There is hereby
 25 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
 26 Officer, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for
 27 disbursements for Arkansas' contribution to various interstate organizations
 28 by the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer for the
 29 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

1 law, in those counties which have juvenile detention facilities. Such
 2 grants/reimbursements for juvenile transportation costs shall be made in
 3 accordance with procedures and criteria developed and administered by the
 4 Office of Criminal Detention Facilities Review Coordinator.

 8 SECTION 58. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHERIFFS
 10 ASSOCIATION. A lump sum monthly installment of at least one-twelfth (1/12)
 11 of the annual allocation provided for in Section 13 of this Act, or so much
 12 thereof as may be made available, shall be provided to the Arkansas Sheriffs
 13 Association to be used exclusively for the establishment and operation of
 14 crime prevention and alcohol and drug abuse programs and for a grant to the
 15 Arkansas Sheriffs' Association to study ways to improve the administration of
 16 sheriffs' offices and developing and improving education programs designed
 17 for sheriffs' offices in Arkansas.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 19 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

→ 21 SECTION 59. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

23 DISTRIBUTION OF ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE FUNDS. In the event that the fund
 24 balance in the Administration of Justice Fund is inadequate to fund the
 25 monthly allocation to State Agencies, the funds will be distributed as
 26 follows:

27 (a) The available revenue and remaining State Administration of Justice
 28 Fund balance shall be distributed first to fully fund the monthly allocations
 29 found in Section 59 of this Act for

30 (1) The Auditor of State to fund the Trial Court Administrative
 31 Assistants Fund,

32 (2) the District Judges Association for the District Court Coordinator,
 33 and

34 (3) the Court Reporter Fund.

35 (b) The total funds remaining in the State Administration of Justice Fund
 36 after the monthly distribution is made under subdivision (a) of this section

1 shall be distributed to the remaining state programs and state agencies
 2 listed in Section 59 of this Act but not listed in subdivision (a) of this
 3 section shall be funded in the percentage of the total funds available in the
 4 Administration of Justice Fund; that is if less than 100% of the total
 5 monthly allocation is available for distribution, monthly allocations for the
 6 remaining agencies will be funded at an equal percentage consistent with the
 7 remaining available funds, provided that any of the allocations listed in
 8 Section 59 that have been fully pledged prior to January 1, 2001 to the
 9 repayment of a bond issue or bond issues shall not be reduced below the
 10 amount listed in Section 59 of this Act. Any shortage from one month will be
 11 adjusted in future months' payments as funds become available.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~

→ 15 SECTION 60. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

17 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. There is hereby allocated to state programs and
 18 agencies, as set out herein, the following allocations of funds appropriated
 19 for State Agencies Distribution in Section 12, to the Department of Finance
 20 and Administration - Disbursing Officer, there to be used as provided by law.

11 SECTION 61. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YEARLY
 13 FUND TRANSFERS. On July 1, 2010 and each July 1, thereafter, if the fund
 14 balance of the Crime Victims Reparation Revolving Fund falls below one
 15 million dollars (\$1,000,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may
 16 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
 17 of the State a sum not to exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or so much
 18 thereof as is available from fund balances that exceed seven million dollars
 19 (\$7,000,000) as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, from the
 20 State Administration of Justice Fund to the Crime Victims Reparations
 21 Revolving Fund to provide funds for personal services, operating expenses and
 22 claims for the Office of the Attorney General - Crime Victims Reparations
 23 Program.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 25 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

27 SECTION 62. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 29 TRANSFER - FIRE AND POLICE PENSION. On or before June 15 of each fiscal
 30 year, the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board shall certify to the
 31 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount of funding it recommends for
 32 disbursement in the ensuing fiscal year to under-funded municipal fire and
 33 police relief and pension plans as defined in Arkansas Code 24-11-217. The
 34 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then immediately transfer on his
 35 books and those of the State Treasurer amounts not to exceed the total amount
 36 recommended by the Board or the amount appropriated herein for the ensuing
