BOARD OF DIRECTORS

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ASSISTED LIVING

Enables a person to live in their own apartment while receiving 24-hour supervision and care while maintaining privacy in their own apartment.

If a person needs help bathing, toileting, eating, and drinking, a trained person at the assisted living residence is there to assist.

Social activities

Help with medications

Other services designed to keep a person in the community

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ASSISTED LIVING (cont'd):

Private Pay Individuals

Living Choices Waiver Eligible Individuals

Arkansans who are age 21 through 64 with a physical disability **OR** Age 65 and older

Meet established financial criteria

Meet nursing home admission criteria at the intermediate level

Room and board costs not included

Have a need for at least one of the available services (i.e. bathing, toileting, eating, and drinking)

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ASSISTED LIVING (cont'd) LEVELS I and II

Individuals requiring Skilled Care are not eligible (I and II)

Staffing qualifications (i.e. RN, CNA, etc.) and ratios vary based on provider license type

Residents eligible for Medicaid benefits (II)

An Intermediate Level of Care is required as determined by the Office of Long-Term Care (II)

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RESIDENTIAL CARE

Independently mobile adult residents whose have impaired functional capabilities but do not require hospital or nursing home care on a daily basis

For individuals who may require assistance in activities of daily living (ADL)

Do not provide nursing or medical services or services to someone in need of hospitalization, substance abuse treatment, and or nursing services
