ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE ON AUTISM AS ESTABLISHED BY ACT 1272 OF 2009

PROPOSED MEETING RULES

- 1. A majority of the twenty-two members of the task force shall constitute a quorum for transacting any business of the task force. A quorum is twelve task force members.
- 2. Task force officers have the right to vote.
- 3. Minutes of each meeting will be produced and adopted at the next meeting.
- 4. Citizens wishing to speak on an issue before the task force will be given an opportunity to speak.
- 5. A motion to adopt a recommendation of the task force must be seconded prior to a vote
- 6. Votes will be voice unless a roll call is requested by two members of the task force. Roll call votes will be recorded in the meeting minutes.
- 7. Only task force members may make recommendations/motions and vote on pending motions.
- 8. Votes cannot be taken via email, as all meetings are public.
- 9. Proxies are allowed for non-legislative members.
- 10. Chairs may appoint "ex-officio" members.
