20 WHEREAS, Mr. Matt DeCample, the former spokesman for Attorney General
21 and Governor Mike Beebe, lost his three-year battle against an extremely rare
22 and aggressive liver cancer on Sunday, March 3, 2019, in Little Rock,
23 Arkansas, at the age of 44; and

25 WHEREAS, a Seattle native who got his start in Arkansas when he was
26 hired to work in the newsroom at Little Rock station KATV, Mr. DeCample was
27 41 years old when he received a Stage 4 cancer diagnosis, a year and a half
28 after the end of the Beebe administration; and

30 WHEREAS, Mr. DeCample endured many hours of chemotherapy with his own
31 delightful blend of blogging, improv comedy, and many deep friendships,
32 saying, "Humor is how I cope. I'm going to make jokes. It comes in handy";

35 WHEREAS, following his work in government, Mr. DeCample went on to
36 become a consultant in media relations and communications, and continued to



1 build on his reputation for honesty, humility, keen intelligence, sincerity,
2 kindness, dependability, and having a quick wit and an ever-present smile;

5 WHEREAS, former Governor Beebe said Mr. DeCample had “the rare
6 combination of an incredibly quick mind and a depth of knowledge that was
7 truly astounding. He was calm and extremely honest and his credibility was
8 unquestioned. We were lucky to have known him. We will not see his like
9 again”,
