22 WHEREAS, for the first time since 2015, the University of Arkansas at  
23 Fayetteville women's Arkansas Razorbacks basketball team qualified for the  
24 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament, earning a No. 4 seed in the  
25 Big Dance and the highest seed for the team since 1991; and

27 WHEREAS, during the regular season, the team became the first women's  
28 team in program history to post back-to-back winning seasons in the  
29 Southeastern Conference, as well as the first to post two (2) top-five wins  
30 in the same season, beating both No. 4 Baylor University with a score of 83-  
31 78 and No. 3 University of Connecticut by a score of 90-87; and

33 WHEREAS, with the in-season win against the University of Connecticut,  
34 the Arkansas Razorback women are just one (1) of nine (9) teams since 2012 to  
35 beat what many consider to be the gold standard in women's college  
36 basketball, and the win against Baylor University was the Arkansas



1 Razorbacks' first victory against a defending national champion since 1996;

4 WHEREAS, Coach Mike Neighbors, in his fourth season with the team, has  
5 led the amazing and talented group of players to these accomplishments; and

7 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Razorbacks women's basketball team has ignited  
8 the fan base and set the record for the two (2) most well-attended games in  
9 all of women's college basketball this season,

11 NOW THEREFORE,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL  
13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 THAT the House of Representatives congratulate Coach Mike Neighbors and  
16 the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville women's basketball team for their  
17 incredible season and success in the NCAA tournament.
