20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 THAT Senator King is authorized to introduce a bill which as introduced
24 will read substantially as follows:

27 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS DATA CENTERS ACT OF 2023; TO AMEND THE UNIFORM
28 MONEY SERVICES ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

31 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS DATA CENTERS ACT OF 2023; AND TO AMEND THE UNIFORM
32 MONEY SERVICES ACT.

34 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
35 ARKANSAS:



1 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-1-604(e), concerning the exemption for a
2 person engaged in home digital asset mining or operating a digital asset
3 mining business under the Uniform Money Services Act, is repealed.

4 ~~(e) A person that is engaged in home digital asset mining or that has~~
5 ~~a digital asset mining business shall not be considered a money transmitter~~
6 ~~under the Uniform Money Services Act, § 23-55-101 et seq.~~

8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-55-102(13)(A), concerning the definition
9 of "money transmission" under the Uniform Money Services Act, is amended to
10 add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

11 (v) engaging in home digital asset mining or
12 operating a digital asset mining business under the Arkansas Data Centers Act
13 of 2023, § 14-1-601 et seq.

15 SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. A person engaging in home digital asset
16 mining or operating a digital asset mining business under the Arkansas Data
17 Centers Act of 2023, § 14-1-601 et seq., as of the effective date of this act
18 shall apply for licensure under the Uniform Money Services Act, § 23-55-101
19 et seq., on or before September 1, 2024."
