24	SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue	
25	Stabilization Law and to create funds, to repeal funds, and to make tr	ansfers
26	to and from funds and fund accounts.

30	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, th	ıe

32	fund to be known as the "Arkansas River Navigation System Fund".	
33	(b) The fund shall consist of:	
34	(1) The taxes and penalties described in § 26-26-1616(d)(2);
35	$\frac{(2)}{(1)}$ Grants made by any person or federal government ag	ency;
36	(3)(2) Any remaining fund balances carried forward from y	ear to

1 year; and 2 (4)(3) Any other funds authorized or provided by law. 3 The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Waterways Commission to 4 develop, improve, and expand river transportation resources within the 5 portion of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System located in the 6 State of Arkansas. 7 8 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 19-5-307 is amended to read as follows: 9 19-5-307. Public Health Fund. The Public Health Fund shall be used for the maintenance, 10 11 operation, and improvement required by the regional health centers and the 12 various divisions of the Department of Health in carrying out the powers, 13 functions, and duties as set out in § 20-7-102 et seq. or other duties 14 imposed by law upon: 15 (1) The Department of Health; 16 (2) The Secretary of the Department of Health; 17 (3) The State Board of Health; and 18 (4) The Secretary of the State Board of Health, or the State 19 Health Officer, whose office was transferred under § 25-9-101 [repealed] to 20 the Department of Health; and 21 (5) The State Cancer Commission, which was transferred to the 22 Department of Health by § 25-9-101 [repealed]. 23 The Public Health Fund shall consist of: (1) Those special revenues as set out in $\S 19-6-301(41)$, (65), 24 25 (68), (69), (80), (97), (131), $\frac{(132)}{}$, (133), (136), (137), (140), (141), 26 (142), (143), (144), (147), (155), (166), (177), (194), (204), (205), (250), 27 and that portion of § 19-6-301(58) of the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-28 101 et seq.; 29 (2) General revenues as may be provided by law; 30 (3) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the 31 various divisions of the Department of Health; 32 (4) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible 33 expenditures by the various divisions of the Department of Health; 34

Administration of Justice Fund to support alcoholism treatment programs and

Arkansas Code § 19-6-405(2), concerning special revenues of 29 the State Highway and Transportation Department Fund, is amended to read as 30 follows: 31 (2) Those special revenues specified in $\S 19-6-301(10)$, (152), 32 (187), and (239), and (241); 33 34 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 35 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's fiscal

laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year; and that it is
