#### 2. Study of College Credit Awarded

#### Advanced Placement:

In 2004-05, 6,446 public high school students took 11,024 AP courses during their senior year.

After high school graduation, **4,572** of these high school seniors were tracked into higher education in Arkansas (either a public or private institution).

The colleges and universities reported that 844 (or 18.5%) of the students who were tracked into higher education in Arkansas were awarded college credit through their AP scores by the end of the student's first two semesters in college.

A total of 6,117 hours of college credit was awarded based on AP scores.

AP students of the 2004-05 academic year earned a GPA of 2.904 their first academic year in college.

#### **Concurrent Enrollment:**

In 2004-05, **8,198** high school students, including seniors and underclassmen, were enrolled in concurrent enrollment courses in public colleges and universities.

After high school graduation, **3,787** of these students were enrolled in an Arkansas college or university in the fall of 2005.

These 3,787 earned 24,572 credit hours through concurrent enrollment courses.

The Concurrent Enrollment students of the 2004-05 academic year earned a GPA of **2.890** during their first academic year in college.
