## A REVIEW OF ADEQUACY IN FINANCING PUBLIC EDUCATION IN ARKANSAS

## A Report Prepared for the Education Adequacy Subcommittee of the Arkansas General Assembly

### **Executive Summary**

Under the Arkansas Constitution, it is the state's responsibility to provide a revenue structure that supports an adequate and equitable education for all students in its public school system.

Adequacy represents an attempt to move beyond considering the fairness of fiscal inputs toward the broad-based improvement of educational outcomes. Adequacy seeks to ensure that all students have a quality education. Adequacy asks, "What level of educational resources is sufficient to generate a specific set of educational outcomes?"

Over the last several years, state government has struggled to transform its approach to financing public education and to fulfill its promise of equal opportunity. Finally, a new funding structure for public schools was enacted by the General Assembly, and adopted by the Arkansas Supreme Court declaring the Arkansas school funding system constitutional.

On behalf of the children of Arkansas, the Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators (AAEA) is appreciative of this progress. However, if we expect children to achieve at high levels, then schools must be funded for success. Dollar for dollar, investing in public education grows the economy more than tax cuts and subsidies.

In the Masters' Interim Report and Final Report it was pointed out that constitutional compliance is an "ongoing task requiring constant study, review and adjustment." Continual assessment and funding priority are provided through state law. Therefore, the AAEA welcomes the opportunity to submit written recommendations and commentary on sustaining and advancing adequate funding for Arkansas public schools.

In the current Foundation Funding Matrix for Adequacy, the AAEA has found inadequacies. The following describes and provides recommendations to correct these inadequacies and adjust other funding factors along with findings and research to support these changes. All recommendations are based on the prototypical 500 student school.

COLA (Cost of Living Adjustment)—As established by Act 124 of 2007, the
Foundation Funding Matrix is to be adjusted each year for inflation of any
appropriate component of the funding system. Due to yearly statutory obligations
for salaries of both certified and classified employees, it is crucial that a COLA be
added each year to those components of the Funding Matrix. The COLA used in the
Matrix should be the same calculation used for state and local government payroll.

- **Staffing**—Add 1.635 FTE to the current 35.665 School-Level Personnel (as established in the Matrix) for a total of 37.30 FTE to provide adequate staff.
- School-Level Salaries—Increase the current teacher salary/benefit amount of \$57,073 by 5% in FY11 and an additional 5% in FY12. Recent updated salary information provided by the ADE indicates that the average teacher salary in Arkansas has fallen to 13<sup>th</sup> of 16 states in the SREB region. Every effort needs to be made to bring the average Arkansas teacher salary up to at least midrange of the SREB states.
- **School-Level Resources (Instructional Materials)**—Increase the current level of funding by restoring the \$25 per pupil expenditure for formative assessments.
- School-Level Resources (Substitutes)—Increase funding for FY11 and FY12 to \$95.09 per ADM which accurately reflects actual substitute costs incurred by Arkansas public schools during FY09.
- Carry-Forward (Operations and Maintenance)—Increase funding for FY11 and FY12 to reflect accurate inflationary indicators for the cost of maintaining and operating schools. AAEA recommends an inflationary factor of 2.7% based on the actual growth of Operations and Maintenance costs over the past four years.
- Carry-Forward (Transportation)—Increase the current level of \$286 per ADM to \$357 per ADM in FY11 and FY12 which represents the actual expenditures in FY09 and develop a high cost transportation category and funding source for those districts with an extremely high number of route miles within their boundaries.
- Categorical Programs—Increase funding for FY11 and FY12 to reflect accurate COLA adjustments since many expenditures from the National School Lunch, English Language Learners, and Alternative Learning Environment categories are for personnel costs.

AAEA also believes that the requirements of the **Educational Excellence Trust Fund** need to be eliminated. The original legislative intent of this Fund was to increase teacher salaries as revenues increased. The actual impact of these requirements has been that the districts experiencing student growth are required to gives raises each year while others are not. Trust Fund requirements have become an unfunded mandate which adds to the salary disparity among districts in the State.

Public school fund balances continue to be an issue of discussion. For the past four years, when comparing legal net balances to yearly total net expenditures, the balances have ranged from 15.8% to 16.9% of the yearly expenditures (Source: Annual Statistical Report for Arkansas Public Schools, 2005-2006 through 2008-2009 – Attachments 1-4). Basically, this represents 2 months worth of expenditures. There

seems to be historical precedence for balance carryovers in this range. School Districts do not receive any foundation funding from June 30 to August 31 each year. These months are also typically months of low collections rates for property taxes. Historically, districts carryover an amount adequate to meet payroll and operating expenses during July and August, or until the first Foundation funds are received for the new fiscal year.

There is little doubt that Arkansas will continue its efforts to provide its children an adequate and equitable public education. The challenge we face is to engage in continuous dialogue and a continuous process of assessing needs and appropriate levels of funding. AAEA appreciates the opportunity to be included in this process.

AAEA greatly appreciates the work of administrators across the state that provided data, recommendations, and time from their busy schedules in assisting the Association in the development of this crucial report. We also thank them for their commitment to quality instruction for the children of Arkansas.

## Findings and Research

## **Staffing** (School Level Personnel)

#### Rationale:

#### Media Specialist

16.02.03 of the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools states, "A school with 300 or more students shall employ a full-time licensed media specialist." The current Matrix only includes a .825 FTE for a medial specialist. **The formula should be increased by .175 FTE for media specialist**. If applied in FY10, the increase in funding would have been \$19.98 per ADM, calculated (.175 FTE \* 57,073)/500 students.

### Staffing Ratios: K-12

The current formula includes 20.8 FTE regular classroom teachers for a school of 500. Under the current Arkansas Standards for pupil-teacher ratios, 20.8 FTE is inadequate. For example, if the 500 enrollment school was a K-4 elementary school and there were approximately 100 students per grade, it would take a minimum of 22.0 FTE to staff the school and meet the current Arkansas Standards for Accreditation. **The 1-3 formula should be increased to 6.0 FTE from the current 5.0 FTE. The 4-12 formula should be increased from 13.8 FTE to 14.0 FTE.** If applied in FY10, the increase in funding for this additional 1.2 FTE would have been \$136.98 per ADM, calculated (1.2 FTE \* 57,073)/500 students.

#### Staffing Ratios: PAM

The Matrix funds PAM teachers at 20% of classroom teachers. Currently, this number is 4.14 FTE in the Matrix. PAM is an acronym for Physical Ed/Art/Music. However, the 2008 Adequacy Report, on page 43, states that this calculation should include **all non-core classroom teachers**. As evidenced by the site visits conducted by the BLR for the 2008 Adequacy Report, the average of PAM/elective teachers is much higher than the 4.14 FTE provided in the Matrix. For example, the Arkansas Standards for Accreditation requires Gifted-Talented services for K-12 students. Gifted-Talented is not currently funded in the Matrix and should be included under this PAM/elective category. If the staffing FTE for K-12 is increased from 20.8 FTE to 22.0 FTE, then **the PAM formula would increase from 4.14 FTE to 4.40 FTE**. If applied in FY10, the increase in funding would have been \$29.68 per ADM, calculated (.26 FTE \* 57,073)/500 students.

#### **School-Level Salaries**

Based on recent ADE calculations, the average teacher salary for Arkansas for 2008-2009 was \$45,156. This calculation, based on National Education Association (NEA) reporting guidelines allows Arkansas to be compared to surrounding states, SREB states, and nationally. **This \$45,156 average ranks Arkansas 13<sup>th</sup> of the 16 SREB states and 4<sup>th</sup> of 7 when comparing Arkansas to the six surrounding states**. (Source: NEA Rankings of the States 2009 and Estimates of School Statistics 2010, released December 2009 — Attachment 5). In the 2008 Adequacy Report (Section 6, page 20), it was reported that Arkansas' average teacher salary, in 2006-2007, was the second highest of surrounding states and ranked 9<sup>th</sup> among the SREB states. The downward trend is obvious and alarming.

## **Instructional Materials** (School-Level Resources)

### Rationale:

On August 30, 2006 consultants Odden and Picus issued their recommendations concerning recalibrating the Arkansas School Funding Structure. This report contained a funding matrix that set forth the funding system now used by Arkansas public schools. Instructional Materials and Library Resources is one category of the funding matrix. The following are the contents of this category:

- Textbooks
- Library Books, Materials, and Electronic Supplies
- Elementary Teacher classroom Requirements
- Formative Assessments

### Formative Assessments

Formative Assessments are recognized as important tools for increasing student achievement. They are given at certain intervals throughout the school year to determine subject concept mastery. Formative assessments were recommended by Odden and Picus as a means of instructional improvement strategies. The requested appropriation of this category was \$25 per pupil for such Formative Assessments. This recommendation for funding was withdrawn during the 2007 Arkansas Legislative Session. District administrators recognize the amount presently spent on Formative Assessments does not reach the level recommended by the Odden/ Picus study; however, school districts are funding Formative Assessments as financially practical with no funding allocated for this category.

In the past several years, many school districts across the state have adopted methods of Formative Assessments as evidenced by:

- 14 Education Service Centers serving 140+ districts with evaluation costs from \$6—\$15 per student, depending upon the number of subject areas assessments developed and then tested.
- The Learning Institute located at Hot Springs serving 30+ of the largest districts in the state with approximately 160,000 students at \$20 per student with a cap of \$60,000 per district.
- A small number of districts employing staff to develop and maintain their own Formative Assessments at the district level.
- Other districts utilizing outside testing vendors to provide targeted formative assessments.

Best practices demand that formative assessments be conducted in order to effectively monitor a student's progress and to make the appropriate curriculum and instructional changes necessary to foster student learning.

## **Substitutes** (School Level Resources)

AAEA believes all school level positions except the principal should have funding for substitutes **including the classified staff**. Actual substitute costs for both certified and classified employees during the 08-09 school year amounted to \$95.09 per ADM. This calculation includes actual expenditures for certified substitutes, classified substitutes, and substitutes paid for through purchased services agreements. (Source: APSCN spreadsheets of actual FY09 expenditures by district in these areas – Attachments 6-8). The \$60.20 per ADM funding in the Matrix for substitutes is severely inadequate.

Substitute issues are more complicated than they appear on the surface. Availability and need vary widely across the state. The need for substitutes during state-mandated testing has dramatically increased in recent years. For example, English Language Learners have an oral test that must be administered by a certified teacher. In districts with large numbers of ELL students, substitute costs during state-mandated testing periods have risen steadily.

When questioned about not including substitutes for custodians, special education paraprofessionals and duty aides, Dr. Picus responded that they were assumed to be hourly employees who did not accrue or have sick leave. This assumption was incorrect in Arkansas, these positions do accrue and are afforded sick leave (§6-17-1304).

## **Operations and Maintenance** (Carry-Forward)

#### Rationale:

All costs—salaries, property insurance and utilities—associated with the operation and maintenance of schools and districts continue to rise dramatically. These costs will always increase and should be adjusted upward each time the funding matrix is recalibrated.

The Annual Statistical Report for Arkansas Public Schools for the past two years shows actual Maintenance and Operation expenses of \$819.57 per ADM in 07-08 and \$852.55 per ADM in 08-09 (Attachments 3-4). Both of these are well above the \$592.60 per ADM currently funded in the Matrix. These figures clearly demonstrate that this part of the Funding Matrix for Adequacy cannot be kept level.

Additionally, successfully managing a school environment is a necessary and essential educational investment. Research increasingly shows that there is a clear link between environmental quality of schools and educational performance:

- Facility management systems determine environmental quality in schools.
- School environment quality shapes attitudes of students, teachers and staff.
- Attitudes affect teaching and learning behavior.
- Behavior affects performance.
- Educational performance determines future outcomes of individuals and society as a whole.

Schools are not primarily environmental showcases. Schools are special environments that exist for the purpose of enhancing the learning process. They are sensitively built housing very special segments of the population. If not properly maintained, schools can be environments where adverse health effects manifest themselves.

The cleanliness of schools is an important aspect of school environments. Clean schools not only lower the threat of the spread of illness, but also convey a caring message to the students and teachers. Cleaning and maintenance of schools is vitally important and is often underemphasized. Students feel better going to clean classes and sitting in clean desks and surroundings.

Adequate funding for operation and maintenance costs is critical to providing a healthy school environment that shapes attitudes and, eventually, positive performance.

#### **Facilities**

Another factor in rising maintenance and operations costs is the dramatic increase in record-keeping and reporting requirements for the Facilities Partnership Program. In an effort to keep up with complex rules and regulations governing Partnership guidelines and applications, Master Planning guidelines, and the Preventive Maintenance quidelines and data maintenance requirements, a number of districts are contracting for these services through the educational cooperatives or through purchased services contract with independent facility specialists. An informal survey of cooperatives indicate that approximately half of the districts in the state are using cooperative or contracted services for facility management services. These facility administrative/clerical costs to districts have never been recognized in the funding matrix.

## **Transportation** (Carry Forward)

The current transportation funding level of \$291.70 per pupil for each year of the biennium was based on the average cost of all Arkansas school districts' actual transportation expenditures in FY05, with very minor adjustments since then. With actual costs for FY08 at \$384.61 per pupil and FY09 at \$357.00 per pupil, the \$291.70 per pupil is severely inadequate. (Source: Annual Statistical Reports for 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 — Attachments 3-4). The funding level for FY11 should be based on actual expenditures per ADM for FY10 with an inflationary index built in each year thereafter.

The wide variances in transportation delivery patterns continue to call for a high cost transportation formula. The Adequacy Report indicates that a study was to be conducted and submitted by February 1, 2007 to address such a formula. While the issue has been discussed to a certain extent, a formula has not been approved.

Additional cost factors not mentioned above includes recent changes in emission standards applicable to transportation vehicles (new EPA emissions standards in 2007 and scheduled again for 2010), increased salary costs, and escalating bus replacement costs. The Arkansas Department of Academic Facilities and Transportation has data indicating that the cost of school busses has risen approximately 40% over the past 10 years. An article in the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette on March 9, 2010 reported that the price of gasoline has been creeping steadily upward since mid-February and some analysts expect the national average to hit \$3 later this spring. This would match a level not seen in the country and Arkansas since October 2008.

## **Categorical Funding**

### Rationale:

Initial financial support for categorical funding was created using the original salary+benefits amount established in the Foundation Formula of \$48,750 in FY04-05. That funding was held level for three years while salaries used in the funding formula increased to \$52,321 in FY06/07, an increase of 7.3%. This oversight was corrected in FY09 and FY10. As school level salaries are adjusted using accurate inflationary indicators, the categorical funding levels (NSL, ELL and ALE) should be subsequently adjusted at the same salary levels. A **COLA**, based on the same calculations for state and local government payroll, needs to be applied for FY11 and FY12.

In consideration of the high levels of fund utilization tied to salaries and benefits, holding the funding levels constant in subsequent years is detrimental to school districts attempts to effectively apply funds to address student needs. Current conditions require that school districts hold adequate reserve balances to offset mandated salary and benefit cost increases.
