19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1 is amended  
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 25-1-118. Electronic filing of reports.

24 (a) As used in this section:

25 (1) "Entity of the state" means:

26 (A) A state agency;

27 (B) The Governor;

28 (C) The Lieutenant Governor;

29 (D) The Attorney General;

30 (E) The Secretary of State;

31 (F) The Auditor of State;

32 (G) The Treasurer of State;

33 (H) The Commissioner of State Lands;

34 (I) The General Assembly; and

35 (J) A committee or subcommittee of the General Assembly,

36 including without limitation the Legislative Council; and

2           (2) "State agency" means every department, division, office,  
3 board, commission, and institution of this state, including state-supported  
4 institutions of higher education.

5           (b) A state agency required by Arkansas law to file a report,  
6 including without limitation a written report, with an entity of the state  
7 shall:

8                   (1) File the report in electronic form; and

9                   (2)(A) Post the report on its Internet website, if applicable.

10                   (B) This subdivision shall not apply if information within  
11 the report is protected from public disclosure by state or federal law.
