"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES -REHABILITATION SERVICES DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES -REHABILITATION SERVICES DIVISION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - REHABILITATION SERVICES DIVISION - FEDERAL. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty (20) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES -REHABILITATION SERVICES DIVISION - FEDERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division, to be payable from the Department of Human Services Federal Funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division, to be payable from the Rehabilitation Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Human Services -Rehabilitation Services Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 5. MESSAGE RELAY CENTER. Of the funds appropriated in Item (04) of Section 4 of this Act, a total of \$169,856 in FY 88 and \$171,342 in FY 89 shall be utilized by the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division to develop and support a statewide 24-hour a day Message

Relay Center designed to improve communication services for the hearing impaired citizens of the State of Arkansas. These services shall be provided through a purchase of service arrangement between the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division and the Arkansas Department of Health.

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES -REHABILITATION SERVICES DIVISION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division, to be payable from the cash funds of the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division, for operating expenses of the Department of Human Services - Rehabilitation Services Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following: ITEM FISCAL YEARS

SECTION 7. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS. Any savings made in State or Federal appropriations for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Social Security and Retirement Matching or Maintenance and General Operation, and Grants for Approved Projects may, after seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council and upon approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, be transferred to the Purchase of Services for disabled and in the establishment, operation and maintenance of facilities, centers or workshops.

SECTION 8. TRANSFER OF FEDERAL FUNDS. The Department of Human Services, after seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council, is authorized to enter into agreements and contracts with the University of Arkansas, the Medical Center, the State Hospital, the Division of Developmental Disabilities, the State supported colleges and other agencies and organizations for the purposes of initiating, conducting and carrying out rehabilitation programs which involve the provision of services to disabled individuals who meet the eligibility requirements of vocational rehabilitation and to carry out research, training and demonstration projects; and to transfer Federal Vocational Rehabilitation funds, through advances or reimbursements, made available to the Rehabilitation Services Division, to such public and private agencies and organizations for approved projects when it is deemed to be in the best interest of service to the adult disabled of the State and in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws and regulations.

SECTION 9. Whereas the current Department of Finance and Administration accounting system will accept current year refunds, credit the current year appropriation and allow expenditure of the funds, the Arkansas State Kidney Disease Commission, administered by the Division of Rehabilitation Services, is authorized to accept prior year refunds and contributions and deposit the funds in the Agency Cash Fund in an account specifically identified as the State Kidney Disease Escrow and disbursed for the purchase of additional services for clients served by the State Kidney Disease Commission. SECTION 10. Whereas the Rehabilitation Services Division currently purchases and sells staff interpreter services for the deaf with four (4) other agencies, the University of Arkansas, the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Arkansas School for the Deaf, and the Judicial Department; and whereas the need for interpreters is immediate and often for crisis purposes and cannot be planned ahead, the Division is authorized to arrange for reimbursement with those agencies, assuring the amount paid from both agencies will not exceed the maximum for the grades they occupy consistent with the intent of Subsection (I) of Section 23 of Act 876 of 1973, as amended, with notification and justification to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, including the document produced by the Bureau of Legislative Research reflecting legislative intent and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 12. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS. The agency, board, commission, department or institution to whom funds are appropriated by this Act shall not enter into any contract for any professional or consultant services which shall extend for more than twenty (20) actual working days or the total compensation exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000) during any one fiscal year without first seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Provided further, that all contracts for professional or consultant services shall be submitted monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for reporting to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
