"AN ACT TO REQUIRE DISABILITY INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE TO INCLUDE AS A COVERED EXPENSE IN VITRO FERTILIZATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. All disability insurance companies doing business in this State shall include as a covered expense in vitro fertilization. The Insurance Commissioner may, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Insurance Code, suspend or revoke the certificate of authority of any insurance company failing to comply with the provisions of this Act. The Insurance Commissioner shall, after conducting appropriate studies and public hearings, establish minimum and maximum levels of such coverage to be provided by the disability insurance companies.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
