"AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE NINTH DAY OF APRIL OF EACH YEAR AS 'PRISONERS OF WAR REMEMBRANCE DAY'; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The ninth day of April of each year shall hereafter be known as "Prisoners of War Remembrance Day." On this day every Arkansan is encouraged to commemorate the sacrifices of those persons who suffered captivity in foreign lands while in the service of their country. Furthermore, all Arkansans are encouraged to devote some portion of "Prisoners of War Remembrance Day" in solemn contemplation on the plight of the men and women of this country who have been held prisoners of war. The superintendent of each public school in this state shall arrange for appropriate exercises on campus to commemorate "Prisoners of War Remembrance Day."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this  $\mbox{Act}$  are hereby repealed.
