"AN ACT RELATING TO THE ABANDONMENT OF PROPERTY AT A DRY CLEANERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any item of clothing left at a dry cleaners which is not claimed within six (6) months shall be deemed abandoned property, and the owner may dispose of the clothing and may retain the proceeds from any sale of of the clothing. If the owner of the dry cleaners disposes of the property pursuant to this section, the owner shall waive all rights to recover fees for performing work on the object.

SECTION 2. This act shall be supplemental to all other laws and shall be deemed to repeal or modify only those laws in direct conflict with it.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
